HERE'S HOW IT WORKS:

- ANY TIME, GO TO www.gaitkeeper.com. CLICK **LOG IN**. THEN **WANT TO REGISTER?** SET UP YOUR PERSONAL ACCOUNT USING YOUR EMAIL AND CREATE A PASSWORD. GO TO HOME AND SELECT YOUR SHOW.
- Gather all the usual information you need when filling out entry forms: membership numbers, USEF recording numbers and correct spellings of names for you, your horse, and anyone else who might ride or train your horse – or coach you --this year. You'll also need everyone's correct address, email, and phone; rider birthdate; horse's age, height, color, gender, breed.
- To start, PUT YOUR CAP LOCK ON. As we are all getting older, this will help make the print BIGGER for everyone!
- Enter people names EXACTLY as they appear on the AHA Card, including middle initials. No nicknames.
- If you prefer to be called something else or have had a name change (like married) CALL AHA and change it.
- If your name is Angeline Jolie-Pitt you are "Jolie-Pitt, Angeline". If your name is LaRae Fletcher Powell you are "Powell, LaRae Fletcher".
- Enter AHA **COMPETITION** Card number in the box that says "Association".
- There is a field for Social Security numbers (SSN). Leave this field blank.
- If you are leasing a horse, enter yourself as Owner last name with "Lessee" as "last name (lessee)". You will need to send copy of lease agreement to show secretary.
- Horse names must be EXACTLY as they appear on registration papers.
 - If the horse has new owners, call AHA to get the papers updated.
 - Do not put AHR or IAHA in front of the number.
 - DO include the 1A, 2A on Half-Arabians.
 - *Canadian* Registry start number with CAHR or CPAR.
 - Horse birthdates are required to be entered as XX/XX/XX example: 01/01/05
 - If your horse has a USEF# (for HOTY Awards program), enter in the box that says AHSA.
- You can enter multiple horses for same Owner by clicking "Add Horse".
- You can enter multiple rider/handlers for same horse(s) by clicking "Add Rider".
- All classes have 3 digits. Class 1 is #001. Use the drop-down class menu to make it easier.
- Be sure to select a Rider# for each class. (*no matter how good your horse is, he needs a rider*)
- Drop down to "Additional Items and Fees" to add your Mandatory per horse fees and any additional items that you need, like Patron Support, Futurity Nominations, etc.
- You can stop and start as many times as you need to, until you click "I have reviewed" and "**SUBMIT**".
- You are not finished until you "SUBMIT".
- This show does not take PAYPAL or VENMO. We take Bank Checks or Credit Cards.
- **PREFERRED PAYMENT:** Make
 - **Checks should be received by May 25th**. checks payable in US Funds to Region 4 AHA. Mail checks to: **Region 4 % Lisa Kolke**. 16017 NE 319th Street, Battle Ground, WA 98604. In Notes reference **REGION 4, Owners Last Name, Horse Name**.
 - **CREDIT CARDS:** You can enter the card number, expiration date and CVV code separately. There is a 3% Convenience Charge (minimum \$5).
- **LAST IMPORTANT STEP:** Everyone sign your Entry Agreement. Mail Entry Agreement (back of entry form) with signatures to show secretary. Include checks for payment. If you are paying with Credit Card, you can mail Entry Agreement (back of entry form) or e-mail PDF file. *Electronic signatures are legal and binding*.
- If you need to make a change after the entry is submitted and before the start of the show, email the correction to horseshownumber@gmail.com. WARM UP RAIL SESSIONS

The purpose of these sessions is to simulate the "show experience" so that everyone can practice and fine tune their entry.

- Additional splits may be made to accommodate multiple horse/rider combinations and/or session sizes. Enter what you need to, we will do our best to accommodate you.
- Sessions must be entered in the show office prior to riding in that session. There is not a "ride through the gate" option.
- These sessions are **not judged** or **awarded**.
- There will be a ringmaster in center ring to supervise and make the gait calls.
- Sessions will be called using the specifications for that discipline. Horses must stay in the gait announced. Please limit schooling.
- Safe and functional tack is required. No illegal schooling equipment.
- Appropriate riding attire and footwear is a requirement. Show Attire is optional.
- We encourage all riders to wear protective headgear passing current applicable ASTM standards with harnesses secured.
- Sessions are not recognized by AHA or USEF

GENERAL PROVISIONS

These classes will be held individually at the Region 4 Championship Show. Rules will be reviewed annually by the futurity committee. Entries will show and be judged by the following Region 4 rules. All rules not covered by this document will be governed by the current rules of the USEF. Reining classes will perform Pattern 5 and be videotaped.

ELIGIBILITY

All entries must be registered with the AHA or CAHR. There is no requirement for Owner's state of residence. Hunter, Western and Country/English pleasure horses to be 3 or 4 years of age. Working Cow and Reining horses to be 3, 4 or 5 year olds. **AOTR classes are restricted to 4 & 5 year olds.**

NOMINATIONS AND FEES

Nominations must be received on or before the dates listed. Nominations may be transferred upon sale of a nominated horse. The futurity secretary must receive notice of sale within 30 days from date of sale. Horses may enter more than one class. There will be no vet-outs, refunds or substitutions. **To avoid late payment charges, all payments must be postmarked by payment date schedule.**

IN 2022, THE FEE SCHEDULE WILL BE:

The Nomination fee per class may be paid as follows:

One payment made by April 1, 2022\$300
Or you may split payments-
1st Payment due April 1, 2022\$175
After April 2nd and before May 25th, add late fee\$25
2nd Payment due May 25, 2022\$175
Entries made after the closing of entries for the show, and up to close of post entries will be \$500.

Nomination fee does not include show entry fees, post entry fees, drug fees, stall fees, etc. Nomination into the Performance Futurity Program does not constitute entry into the Regional Show. A separate Regional Show Entry form must be submitted with the appropriate entry fees prior to the close of entries in order for the horse to be shown in the specified Performance Futurity Classes.

PRIZE MONEY AND AWARDS

Regional Awards will be given to an unrated full top five followed by champion & reserve. All money received from nominations will be allocated for prize money. Payments credited toward specific class entered. Prize money divided:

5 or more entries: champion 45%, reserve 22%, remaining top 5 will receive 11% each.

4 entries: champion 50%, reserve 25%, remaining entries 12.5%.

3 entries: champion 55%, reserve 30%, remaining entry 15%.

2 entries: champion 60%, reserve 40%.

TACK AND APPOINTMENTS

Country / English Pleasure

3 & 4 year old classes Bridle shall be a light show type bridle. Must be shown in a single snaffle (smooth, rounded snaffle bit at least 3/8 in diameter as measured 1/2 from the ring). The rings may be from 2" to 4" outside diameter. Half cheeks are optional. The snaffle bit may be wrapped with Latex, Guard tex or a similar material. Cavessons are required. A running martingale is optional. Entries may have been shown in a bridle. Bridle is defined as any bit that has a shank.

Hunter Pleasure

3 & 4 year old classes require a snaffle bit. (Snaffle bit is defined as snaffle bit of at least 3/8" diameter as measured 1/2" from the ring. The snaffle bit may be jointed, double jointed or unjointed. For all junior horse performance classes, all snaffle bits must have a round, egg butt or "D" shaped ring with no attachments to the headstall or reins through a hook (except for keepers for a full cheek snaffle when section rules allow a full cheek). Full cheek (with or without keepers), French and Dr. Bristol snaffle bits are permitted). The following are not permitted: ornamented bridles, browbands or cavessons, saddle seat style colored browbands/cavessons, figure eight, drop, or flash nosebands. Breastplate or breast collar is optional. No martingales or tie-downs. **AOTR Classes require a light show type bridle, browband and cavessons must be of hunter type. Snaffle, pelham, full bridle or kimberwicke bit acceptable.**

Western Pleasure, Ranch Riding, Reining & Working Cow

ALL classes require a snaffle bit or hackamore. A standard snaffle bit is defined as a center jointed single, rounded, unwrapped, smooth mouthpiece of 5/16" to 3/4" diameter metal as measured from ring to 1" in from the ring with a gradual decrease to the center of the snaffle. The rings may be from 2" to 4" outside diameter of either loose type, eggbutt, dee, or center mounted without cheeks. If a curb strap is used it must be attached below the reins. A hackamore includes a bosal rounded in shape and constructed of braided rawhide or leather and must have a flexible non-metallic core, attached to a suitable headstall. No other material of any kind is to be used in conjunction with the bosal, i.e., steel, metal or chains (Exception: smooth, plastic electrical tape is acceptable if applied in a smooth, untwisted manner). Attached reins may be of hair, rope, or leather. Both hands must be visible to the judge. Two hands may be used on hackamore (Bosal) and Western snaffle reins. Junior Western Pleasure horses shown in either a hackamore or snaffle must never have been shown in any Arabian Competition/Division Western Pleasure event in a bridle. (Except Trail, Reining, Reined Cow Horse and Working Cow Horses).

DECLARATION OF CLASSES

It is recommended but not necessary to declare a class with payments. **You may not change classes after your entries have been processed by the show**

MEMBERSHIP REQUIREMENTS

USEF MEMBERSHIP STATEMENT



Life, senior active and junior active members shall be eligible to participate in all classes at Regular Competitions, Eventing Competitions at the Modified Level or above and Combined Driving Competitions at the Advanced Level, Dressage, Reining and Vaulting Competitions and Endurance Rides. A nonmember may participate as a handler, rider, driver, owner, lessee, agent, coach or trainer at Regular Competitions, Eventing Competitions, Dressage Competitions, Reining Competitions and Combined Driving Competitions upon payment of a \$45 Show Pass fee. Participants in the following classes are exempted from the Requirements of this rule: 1) leadline; 2) exhibitions; 3) games and races; 4) classes for 4-H members; 5) walk trot (exception: Friesian performance FR222) and academy classes (academy classes are classes limited to horses used regularly in a lesson program); 6) USDF introductory level tests, pas de deux and quadrille classes; 7) NRHA Endorsed Reining Competitions. 8) Opportunity classes, 9) citizens of other nations who have proof, in English, of current membership in good standing of their own National Federation, 10) USEA beginner novice division; and 11) assistant handlers in Dressage Sport Horse Breeding classes (01/19/2022)

Amateur Certification • Only active Federation members may obtain amateur certification. Every person who has reached his/her 19th birthday and competes in classes for amateurs under Federation rules must possess current amateur certification issued by the Federation. Only active Federation members may obtain amateur certification, Amateur cards are no longer available for non-members. Any person who has not reached his/her 19th birthday is an amateur and does not require amateur certification. An amateur continues to be such until he/she has received a change in status from the Federation. There is no fee for amateur certification for Senior Active or Life Members. Refer to GR1306 & GR1307. **Any Active Equine Canada member who is not a current USEF member** and wants to compete in an amateur class must fill out the USEF membership application with their name, signature, date of birth and check the "Amateur" box in order to be eligible to compete. They are not required to pay for a USEF membership or a Show Pass fee. Once the application has been processed, their amateur status will then show up on the USEF website – usef.org and under Search, Membership as "Non-Member Amateur – INACTIVE".

USEF Non-Member Participation • if proper competing membership documentation is not submitted to the competition and the competition cannot verify such information, the exhibitor will be required to complete a Show Pass form and pay a non-refundable Show Pass fee of \$45.00. (GR1308.1c) Purchase of a Show Pass fee does NOT allow a competitor to show in amateur classes. To show in an amateur class, an adult competitor must provide proof of membership with amateur certification. Walk/trot only riders are exempt. www.usef.org

REMINDER: US EQUESTRIAN SAFE SPORT –All USEF Life and Senior Active members, as well as participants who have regular contact with minor athletes, are required to comply with the U.S. Center for SafeSport training requirement to be eligible to participate in the competition. All participants must adhere to the U.S. Center for SafeSport Code, USEF Safe Sport Policy, and the Minor Athlete Abuse Prevention Policies. AHA MEMBERSHIP STATEMENT

EACH COMPETITOR (THIS INCLUDES AT LEAST ONE RECORDED OWNER AND ALL TRAINERS, DRIVERS, RIDERS, HALTER HANDLERS, COACHES AND THE PERSON(S) SIGNING THE ENTRY BLANK) IN AN ARABIAN HORSE ASSOCIATION RECOGNIZED ARABIAN DIVISION, AT THE TIME OF ENTRY INTO A COMPETITION, MUST SUBMIT A COPY OF A VALID AHA MEMBERSHIP/COMPETITION CARD, JOIN AHA OR PAY AN AHA SINGLE EVENT MEMBERSHIP FEE PER COMPETITOR. WHEN AN AGENT SIGNS FOR THE OWNER AT AN AHA RECOGNIZED COMPETITION, BOTH THE OWNER AND AGENT MUST BE MEMBERS OF AHA OR PAY THE AHA SINGLE EVENT MEMBERSHIP. SINGLE EVENT MEMBERSHIP IS NOT ACCEPTABLE AT AHA REGIONAL OR NATIONAL COMPETITIONS. EXHIBITORS IN WALK-TROT CLASSES ARE EXEMPT FROM AHA MEMBERSHIP REQUIREMENTS AT QUALIFYING COMPETITIONS, BUT MUST HAVE AN AHA MEMBERSHIP WITH COMPETITION CARD AT AHA REGIONAL AND NATIONAL COMPETITIONS. EXHIBITORS IN LEAD LINE CLASSES OR PARENTS/GUARDIANS SIGNING FOR MINORS ARE EXEMPT FROM AHA MEMBERSHIP REQUIREMENTS. (BOD 5/12)



AHA Competition Card Requirements • All riders, drivers, owners, agents and handlers who exhibit horses in the show ring or sign the entry form as the responsible party for any individual's horses at the show must be AHA COMPETITION level members with competition cards. **If the recorded owner is an entity (Farm, Ranch, Syndicate, etc.) it must have a current AHA Business membership.** AHA does not permit Single Event Memberships at AHA Regional Championship Shows. An AHA COMPETITION membership is required for all, including walk/trot riders. Lead Line or Parent/Guardian signing for minors are exempt.

MANAGEMENT RESERVES THE RIGHT TO REFUSE ANY ENTRY IN ACCORDANCE WITH GR914. EACH PARTICIPANT IN THIS SHOW IS RESPONSIBLE FOR KNOWLEDGE OF AND IS SUBJECT TO THE USEF RULES. Amateur Owner Classes • Horses entered in amateur owner and junior owner classes must be registered in the name of the competitor or a member of the competitor's family, as defined by USEF Rules. Horses registered in a farm/ranch/syndicate/ partnership/corporation name may be shown in Amateur Owner classes provided the family is the sole owner of the farm or entity. The sale of a horse does not eliminate this registration requirement. Every competitor must be an amateur and the owner, or an amateur member of the owner's family. Leased horses are not eligible. (Contracts of Sale or Bill of Sale will not be accepted in Owner Classes.)

Amateur Owner "Family" Definition • For ownership by the same family, the term family includes the following: spouse, parent, step-parent, child, step-child, brother, sister, half brother and sister, aunt, uncle, niece, nephew, step-brother and sister, grandparents and grandchildren, and in-laws of the same relation as stated above.

Combined ownership is permitted in Junior Owner's or Amateur Owner's classes under the following conditions:

- Two distinct non-family owners may co-own a horse and show that horse in Junior Owner or Amateur Owner classes except that no family member of a professional may enter into this relationship. 'Non-family owners' are defined as two distinct individuals who are not related as family as defined by US Equestrian or Equestrian Canada.
- A horse that is co-owned by the two distinct non-family owners must be registered with Arabian Horse Registry of America, Half Arabian Horse Registry, Anglo Arabian Horse Registry, Canadian Arabian Horse Registry or Canadian Partbred Arabian Registry, or other registry approved by the Arabian Horse Association as an "and" ownership relationship. An "or" ownership relationship does not enable two distinct non-family owners to show in Junior Owner's or Amateur Owner's classes.
- The right to show horses in Junior Owner or Amateur Owner classes when there are two distinct non-family owners registered as the owners of said horse, does not extend to the family of these distinct non-family owners.
- In order to show in Junior Owner or Amateur Owner classes both distinct non-family owners must be members of US Equestrian or Equestrian Canada and hold valid amateur cards or be juniors or a combination of amateur and junior.
- Both distinct non-family owners must be individuals, no farm or corporation co-owned horses are eligible.
- No family member of a distinct non-family owner may receive any remuneration in relation to the co-owned horse as defined in SUBCHAPTER 13-B AMATEURS AND PROFESSIONALS (or Equestrian Canada equivalent).
- Horses co-owned by more than two distinct non-family owners cannot be shown in Junior Owner or Amateur Owner classes.
- If the co-ownership relationship is terminated, that horse is not eligible to be co-owned by another distinct non-family person for the remainder of that show year as defined by US Equestrian. The remaining owner and his or her family members are eligible to show in Junior Owner or Amateur Owner classes.
- A horse that is co-owned by the two distinct non-family members cannot be shown in any Maturity or Jackpot classes at any AHA national championship show.
- An individual AHA affiliate association/club may elect to not allow horses that are co-owned by two distinct non-family members to compete in classes designated for Amateur Owner or Junior Owner for which they offer prize money, Futurity, or other restricted classes with payouts greater than \$2,500.
- An individual member may only enter into two distinct co-owner relationships and compete with these arrangements in Amateur Owner or Junior Owner classes at USEF/EC-approved shows. Arrangements with other individuals, same as otherwise, for purposes other than competing in USEF/EC-approved shows in Amateur Owner and Junior Owner classes, are not impacted.

Admission to the Arena and Paddock Area • No person will be allowed in the ring except participants in the class, licensed officials, assistants, and show photographer. Properly attired attendants will be allowed in the ring only after being called by the judge, ringmaster, or announcer. There shall be no conduct in the paddock area which disturbs or creates a hazard to horses, handlers, or spectators.

Attention Competitors • Each competitor is responsible for supplying management with correct association numbers (USEF, Equine Canada, AHA) for horse, owner, rider/driver/handler, trainer and coach before the day(s) of the competition. The scores of competitors who fail to supply correct numbers may not be counted toward national awards and breed association programs.

Awards of Prize Money • Every effort will be made to have checks available in the awards room during the posted hours. Checks must be signed for and everyone who receives a payout will need to complete a W-9 in order to receive their check regardless of the amount. Checks will be void after 60 days.

Region 4 Futurity classes: Net money received from nominations will be allocated for prize money. Payments credited toward specific class entered.

ABS Sweepstakes classes: All prize money will be distributed by AHA.

RULES & GENERAL INFORMATION

Awards of Trophies and Ribbons • The awards room is located in the Sports Arena Building. The hours of operation will be posted on the door for your convenience. Placings are not final until the judge's cards and score sheets have been publicly posted. Once results are confirmed and posted, awards may be picked up and signed for at the awards room. Unclaimed awards will not be mailed.

A full Top Five will be awarded regardless of the number of entries in a class. However, only awards made to the top 50% of the class (rounded up and not to exceed 5 awards) will receive Arabian Breeders Sweepstakes payouts, AHA Horse Achievement Awards, Amateur Achievement Awards, High Point Horse Achievement Awards, High Point Amateur Achievement Awards and Distance Award points. All Top Five Awards will qualify for the corresponding national championship.

Region 4 Championship Classes: Champion – Award, Champion Ribbon, Garland. Reserve Champion – Award, Reserve Champion Ribbon. Entire Top 5 will receive Top 5 award and ribbon. ABS Sweepstakes ribbons will be awarded to enrolled horses in ABS Sweepstakes classes.

Regional ABS Yearling Halter Classes – Top Ten ribbons to 10th. Champion – Award, Champion Ribbon, Garland. Reserve Champion – Award, Reserve Champion Ribbon.

Region 4 Futurity Classes: Champion – Silver Belt Buckle, Award, Champion Ribbon, Garland. Reserve Champion – Award, Reserve Champion Ribbon. Entire Top 5 will receive Top 5 award and ribbon.

Call for classes • Due to unforeseeable problems with any mechanical device, the public address system must be considered a courtesy. It is the exhibitors' responsibility to follow how quickly classes are progressing and to promptly present themselves when the gate person calls for their class.

Changes, Cancellation or Division of classes • Management reserves the right to make changes of arenas, judges or class order to facilitate time schedule and conditions for betterment of the Show. The Show Committee reserves the right to cancel, combine, or divide any classes or make any scheduling changes necessary. All changes will be posted on the Announcement Board at the office. Any performance championship that reaches 30 entries competing will be shown as a semifinal class with horses selected by the judges for final competition. ***The AAOTR Western, Country and Hunter Pleasure classes have been split by age into 19-49 and 50 & Over. If any of those splits has fewer than 5 entries, the two age groups for that class will be combined and run as one Regional class.***

Change of Horse in Showmanship/Equitation Classes • Please have all changes made by 7PM the night prior to the class. If the draw order has been done, exhibitors with horse changes will stay as assigned.

Discipline • Exhibitors are advised that any act of discourtesy or disobedience to staff or officials of this show on part of the owner, exhibitor, agent, lessee, trainer, groom, rider, driver, handler, or family of the person participating in the show, will disqualify the horse from adjudication. Management reserves the right to remove a horse or any person from the show without being liable for compensation or damages.

Disputes not covered by the rules • Should any question or dispute arise not provided for in the governing rules of USEF and AHA, the same shall be referred to the Show Commission whose decision shall be final.

Drug and medication rule • Refer to USEF Chapter 4, The official Medication Report Form is now on line at: <https://competitions.usef.org/drugs-and-meds/medication-report-form/usef>.

Equitation Music • Exhibitors in Saddle Seat Equitation will be allowed to submit their own music selection for their regional championship class. Music requests (compact discs or digital media accepted) must be submitted to the show office before 7pm the night prior to the day their class is held.

Gate Hold • In classes where horses compete collectively, a warning will be made and the in-gate must be closed two minutes after the first horse enters the ring. When it is found that a gate hold must be requested by an exhibitor, such request shall be made to the Paddock Master prior to the close of judging of the class immediately before the class requiring the gate hold. The reason for the request must be stated. The gate-hold will be a maximum of three (3) minutes. Appropriate notice will be given to all exhibitors if there is a gate hold in effect.

Judges • The Show Commission reserves the right to substitute a judge for one who is officially designated.

Leveling Program (Select, Choice, Elite & Primetime Classes) • A rider may now choose to ride any and all levels at or above their given level but cannot ride below their designated level. For Example, if you are a Select Hunter Pleasure Rider, you will be able to ride in Hunter Pleasure Select AATR, Hunter Pleasure Choice AATR and, if you own the horse, Hunter Pleasure AAOTR. You can find your appropriate "level" by clicking on "Horse/Rider Points and Competition Records" from the AHA website member home page. Look for the access link labeled "Leveling Points". The view is broken into various sections, i.e., Hunter, Western, and Saddle Seat. You can use the summary at the bottom of the page along with the "leveling chart" to determine your level for the appropriate class. It is the rider's responsibility to enter the correct level. RULES & GENERAL INFORMATION

Order of go • All Breeding/Gelding In-Hand classes will be oldest to youngest, including post entries. All working western, equitation pattern classes and showmanship classes will have a posted order of go a minimum of twenty-four (24) hours at Regional Championships. All “orders of go” will be posted on the Announcement Board at the Show Office and given to the Paddock Master not less than one hour prior to the start of that class. Accommodations may be made in the case of class conflicts.

Scoring Systems • All Regional Cutting, Reining, Reined Cow, Working Cow & Ranch Horse Riding classes will be judged by a single judge. Regional Trail classes will be judged by a single judge, using the AHA Trail scoring system. The “Comparative system (MOS)” will be used for all Breeding/Gelding In-Hand classes. Performance Halter horses will be judged using the Arabian Performance Halter Score Card. The scorecards will be turned into placings and in turn, run through the Majority Opinion System (MOS) to determine the Champion, Reserve Champion and Top Five. The AHA approved Majority Opinion System (MOS) will be used for all other classes.

Region 4 Performance Futurities Entries will show and be judged under Futurity rules and applicable class specifications for junior horses as set forth in the Arabian division of the USEF rule book and will utilize MOS scoring. See complete rules on the website.

Stallions • May be shown in any class except classes for Walk/Trot 10 & Under and Lead Line.

Sweepstakes Classes (ABS) • (excluding AHA Breeders Sweepstakes Yearling classes) are open to all horses, however, only horses enrolled in the (ABS) Arabian Breeders Sweepstakes program will earn payouts.

The Dog Park is located by the Barn Office. **Pet owners are required to clean up after their pets in all areas including barns and RV parking.** Pet owners failing to comply with this rule may be subject to penalty under Chapters 6 and 7, as well as issuance of warning cards (GR1301.6)

Feed and Bedding • Feed & hay are available from the facility. Deliveries are made twice daily: 10AM – NOON; 4PM – 6PM. Call 208-442-3335. No outside bedding allowed on show grounds. Used bedding must be deposited in the manure dumps supplied.

Food • Food will be available on the show grounds. Check concessions for hours of operation. Absolutely no outside food and beverages allowed inside the Sports Center. No alcohol permitted anywhere on Ford Idaho Center property.

Haul-in/Trailer fee • All horses hauling in to show a single day must purchase a day stall at a cost of \$45. Day stall rental is from 7AM to the end of that day's show. **You may not show out of your trailer at this show.**

Motorized Vehicles • Minors who do not have a valid driver's license which allows them to operate a motorized vehicle in the state in which they reside will not be permitted to operate a motorized vehicle of any kind, including, but not limited to, golf carts, motorcycles, scooters, or farm utility vehicles, on the competition grounds of licensed competitions. Minors who have a valid temporary license may operate the above described motorized vehicles as long as they are accompanied by an adult with a valid driver's license. The parent/legal guardian or individual who signs the entry blank as a parent or guardian of a minor operating a motorized vehicle in violation of this rule are solely responsible for any damages, claims, losses or actions resulting from that operation. Violations of this rule will be cause for penalties against those responsible for the child committing the offense. Wheelchairs and other mobility assistance devices for individuals with disabilities are exempt from this rule. The unsafe use of personal electronic transport devices, as determined by the competition officials and management in their sole discretion, that do not require a driver's license to operate, including but not limited to segways, hover boards, and single wheeled scooters is prohibited on competition grounds. Operating such devices in areas where people gather may be deemed "unsafe use" if there is a risk of harm to others. If the operator of the device is a minor, the parent/legal guardian or individual who signs the entry blank as a parent or guardian of a minor operating the device in violation of this rule is accountable and may be subject to penalties. Wheelchairs and other mobility assistance devices for individuals with disabilities are exempt from this rule. (01/19/2022)

Non-Competing Horses on the show grounds • Horses not entered in the show will be allowed on the show grounds. These horses must have an individually assigned stall (not shared) and a signed liability release form in the horse show office.

Outside / Exhibitor Alcohol • As per Idaho State Law, no alcoholic beverages are permitted inside the Sports Center unless served by the official liquor license holder, Sodexo. Please refrain from using glass containers anywhere on the facility grounds.

Parking • All vehicles must be kept in designated parking areas. Trailers may be pulled to the barns to load and unload. 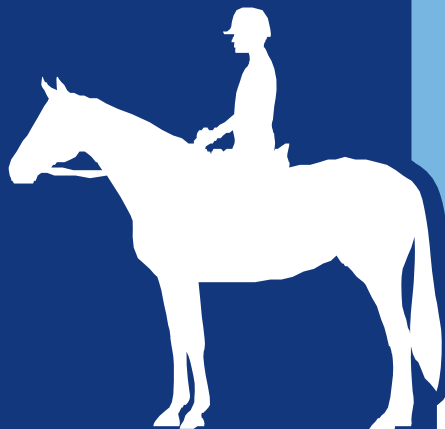

I AGREE that I choose to participate voluntarily in this Competition, as a rider, driver, handler, lessee, owner, agent, coach, trainer, junior exhibitor, or as a parent or guardian of a junior exhibitor. **I AM FULLY AWARE AND ACKNOWLEDGE THAT HORSE SPORTS AND PARTICIPATION IN THIS COMPETITION INVOLVE SERIOUS RISK OF HARM INCLUDING, BUT NOT LIMITED TO, RISKS OF ACCIDENT, SERIOUS BODILY INJURY, INCLUDING DEATH, BROKEN BONES, HEAD INJURIES, TRAUMA, PAIN, AND SUFFERING, AND PROPERTY DAMAGE. I ASSUME ALL RISKS OF HARM TO ME, MY HORSE OR MY PROPERTY.**

I AGREE as a Horse Show Participant (or Parent/Guardian of Participant if a minor) to waive all claims which may otherwise arise from, including but not limited to infectious bacteria, viruses, fungi/mold, parasites, or other agents which may be present at the Horse Show (and most other outdoor locations) and can cause infection in humans, as well as in animals.

For and in consideration of United States Equestrian Federation, Inc. dba US Equestrian (“USEF”) allowing me, the undersigned, to participate in any capacity (including as a rider, driver, handler, vaulter, longeur, lessee, owner, agent, coach, official, trainer or volunteer) in a USEF sanctioned, licensed or approved event or activity, including but not limited to equestrian clinics, practices, shows, competitions and related or incidental activities and **REGION 4 AHA CHAMPIONSHIPS (“USEF Event” or “USEF Events”)**; I, for myself, and on behalf of my spouse, children, heirs and next of kin, and any legal and personal representatives, executors, administrators, successors,, and assigns, hereby agree to and make the following contractual representations pursuant to this Agreement (the “**Agreement**”):

A. RULES AND REGULATIONS: I hereby agree that I have read, understand, and agree to be bound by all applicable Federation Bylaws, rules, and policies including the USEF Safe Sport Policy and Minor Athlete Abuse Prevention Policies (MAAPP) as published at www.usef.org, as amended from time to time.

B. 2. Qualification period is the previous year plus the current year up to the close of entries. *(Placings in 2021 count towards 2022 qualification period – if your placing was not recorded, you will need to qualify in 2022 under the participation system)*
3. Compete in any qualifying AHA Recognized show in any region *(which includes Concurrent, Pre-Show, Value Show)*.
4. Compete in a [recognized section](#), i.e., HA/AA Western Pleasure, Arabian Country English Pleasure, Arabian Hunter Pleasure, etc.
5. Compete in any recognized class within that section *(Note: for Dressage, each level is considered its own section)*.
