Entries • See the table “DATES, DEADLINES, CANCELLATIONS & CHANGES”. If the entry is **NOT RECEIVED BY** this date, it will be considered a late entry and post entry fees will be added to your entry. **By signing and submitting an entry to this show, it is your intent to show and agree to our rules. You agree to pay all fees due and understand that refunds will not be made except by the policy stated.**

ON-LINE ENTRIES WITH GAITKEEPER.COM

The **preferred** method for entering this show is to use www.gaitkeeper.com to enter.

This show will accept bank checks by mail and PayPal only. (no credit cards will be processed)

You will still need to mail or e-mail the following:

- The AHA/USEF Release Form (the usual one) with all required signatures. Remember, minors cannot sign.
- The USEF Waiver of Liability for EACH person on your entry form; one form per person.
- The completed Qualification form for each horse and equitation rider.
- If leasing or purchasing horse on contract and showing under your ownership, then send a copy of the agreement.

Entry Cancellations, Refunds & Substitutions • To encourage early entries,

1. If an exhibitor vets out a horse between the close of entries and **before 7pm May 26th**, and brings a replacement horse, the post entry for such regional class will be waived.
2. Absolutely no requests for refunds for any reason will be considered unless the request with supporting documentation is in the show secretary's hand prior to 7PM, **May 26, 2025**, for consideration by the Show Commission. Such a refund will include all fees less a \$50 cancellation fee.
3. After 7PM **May 26, 2025**, no refunds will be made except in the case of unusual situations. The Show Commission reserves the right to review these situations case by case upon receipt of a written request with supporting documentation.
4. In the event of show cancellation due to severe weather or other emergency, refunds of entry fees, less a \$25 processing fee, will be made upon written request by the exhibitor within 30 days of the cancellation.
5. No substitution of horses will be permitted except as provided in USEF rules.

Entry Confirmation • Will be sent via e-mail to the legible email address on your entry. Please check the acknowledgement for accuracy and requests for additional information and/or monies to avoid incomplete entry charges and delays in the show office when you arrive at the show. **All communication with exhibitors, owners and trainers will be via email. To make sure that you are getting all of our information, put your email address on your entry form or email it to us at horseshownumber@gmail.com.** Various correspondence may be sent via email to the email address that is currently on file with AHA. If you need to update your email address, you can log on to your AHA account on the AHA website, or you can call the AHA office at 303-696-4500 and they can update the address for you.

Entry Payment • Make checks payable in US Funds to **Region 4 AHA**. Show Management cannot accept an entry unless it is accompanied by a valid check, money order PayPal for the full amount of the entry costs, including entry fees, drug fee, and AHA and USEF non-member fees. Full balance owed on entries is due at time of processing of entries. Entries received without a valid check, money order or PayPal will not be processed until payment is received and will be subject to post entry penalties if payment is postmarked after close of entries.

OPEN CHECKS - At check-in, before show numbers will be released, all exhibitors will be required to leave an open check, separate from their entries to cover any additional entries, fines or penalties incurred at the show. Check will be used to settle monies due. International exhibitors must draw all checks on U.S. Funds.

Refusal of Entries: • The Region 4 AHA Board of Delegates has directed that entries must be refused from anyone who has an outstanding obligation to a Region 4 affiliated club, show or contracted services. Management reserves the right to hold classes conditionally, or cancel the entries of any contestant, as stated in USEF Rules. The commission reserves the right to remove any horse or person from the show who has shown an objectionable attitude or behavior towards its management, or previous unsportsmanlike behavior, without being liable for compensation or damages.

Returned Checks & Denied PayPal Transaction • Dishonored checks **and/or declined PayPal Transaction** will incur a \$50 charge per domestic failure (\$75 per International check). Payments will not be processed through the bank a second time. To retain entries, fees plus penalty must be paid by US money order, cashier's check, cash, or alternate PayPal within 7 days of notification or post entries will be applied to your entry. In the event a check is returned or PayPal denied by the bank after the completion of the show, it will be handled in accordance with USEF GR913.

GENERAL PROVISIONS

These classes will be held individually at the Region 4 Championship Show. Rules will be reviewed annually by the futurity committee. Entries will show and be judged by the following Region 4 rules. All rules not covered by this document will be governed by the current rules of the USEF. Reining classes will perform Pattern 5 and be videotaped.

ELIGIBILITY

All entries must be registered with the AHA or CAHR. There is no requirement for Owner's state of residence. Hunter, Western and Country/English pleasure horses to be 3 or 4 years of age. Working Cow and Reining horses to be 3-, 4- or 5-year-olds. **AOTR classes are restricted to 4 & 5 year olds.**

NOMINATIONS AND FEES

Nomination forms must be received on or before the dates listed and must include a W-9 Form. Nominations may be transferred upon sale of a nominated horse. The futurity secretary must receive notice of sale within 30 days from date of sale. Horses may enter more than one class. There will be no vet-outs, refunds or substitutions. **To avoid late payment charges, all payments must be postmarked by payment date schedule.**

IN 2025, THE FEE SCHEDULE WILL BE:

The Nomination fee per class may be paid as follows:

One payment made by April 1, 2025.....	\$300
<i>Or you may split payments-</i>	
1 st Payment due April 1, 2025.....	\$175
After April 2 nd and before April 29 th , add late fee.....	\$25
2 nd Payment due April 29 th	\$175

Nominations made after the closing of entries for the show, and up to close of post entries will be \$500.

Nomination fees do not include show entry fees, post entry fees, drug fees, stall fees, etc. Nomination into the Performance Futurity Program does not constitute entry into the Regional Show. A separate Regional Show Entry form must be submitted with the appropriate entry fees prior to the close of entries in order for the horse to be shown in the specified Performance Futurity Classes.

PRIZE MONEY AND AWARDS

Regional Awards will be given to an unrated full top five followed by champion & reserve. All money received from nominations will be allocated for prize money. Payments credited toward specific class entered. Prize money divided:

5 or more entries: champion 45%, reserve 22%, remaining top 5 will receive 11% each.

4 entries: champion 50%, reserve 25%, remaining entries 12.5%.

3 entries: champion 55%, reserve 30%, remaining entry 15%.

2 entries: champion 60%, reserve 40%.

TACK AND APPOINTMENTS

Country / English Pleasure

3- & 4-year-old classes Bridle shall be a light show type bridle. Must be shown in a single snaffle (smooth, rounded snaffle bit at least 3/8 in diameter as measured 1/2 from the ring). The rings may be from 2" to 4" outside diameter. Half cheeks are optional. The snaffle bit may be wrapped with Latex, Guard tex or a similar material. Cavessons are required. A running martingale is optional. Entries may have been shown in a bridle. Bridle is defined as any bit that has a shank.

Hunter Pleasure

3- & 4-year-old classes require a snaffle bit. (Snaffle bit is defined as snaffle bit of at least 3/8" diameter as measured 1/2" from the ring. The snaffle bit may be jointed, double jointed or unjointed. For all junior horse performance classes, all snaffle bits must have a round, egg butt or "D" shaped ring with no attachments to the headstall or reins through a hook (except for keepers for a full cheek snaffle when section rules allow a full cheek). Full cheek (with or without keepers), French and Dr. Bristol snaffle bits are permitted). The following are not permitted: ornamented bridles, browbands or cavessons, saddle seat style colored browbands/cavessons, figure eight, drop, or flash nosebands. Breastplate or breast collar is optional. No martingales or tie-downs. **AOTR Classes require a light show type bridle, browband and cavessons must be of hunter type. Snaffle, pelham, full bridle or kimberwicke bit acceptable.**

Western Pleasure, Ranch Riding, Reining & Working Cow

ALL classes require a snaffle bit or hackamore. A standard snaffle bit is defined as a center jointed single, rounded, unwrapped, smooth mouthpiece of 5/16" to 3/4" diameter metal as measured from ring to 1" in from the ring with a gradual decrease to the center of the snaffle. The rings may be from 2" to 4" outside diameter of either loose type, eggbutt, dee, or center mounted without cheeks. If a curb strap is used it must be attached below the reins. A hackamore includes a bosal rounded in shape and constructed of braided rawhide or leather and must have a flexible non-metallic core, attached to a suitable headstall. No other material of any kind is to be used in conjunction with bosal, i.e., steel, metal or chains (Exception: smooth, plastic electrical tape is acceptable if applied in a smooth, untwisted manner). Attached reins may be of hair, rope, or leather. Both hands must be visible to the judge. Two hands may be used on hackamore (Bosal) and Western snaffle reins. Junior Western Pleasure horses shown in either a hackamore or snaffle must never have been shown in any Arabian Competition/Division Western Pleasure event in a bridle. (Except Trail, Reining, Reined Cow Horse and Working Cow Horses).

DECLARATION OF CLASSES

It is recommended but not necessary to declare a class with payments. **You may not change classes after your entries have been processed by the show.**





Dogs (& Other pets) • Pets are not allowed in any arena or warmup area. Pets are not permitted to be loose on competition grounds and must be on a leash or otherwise contained. Individuals must not lead pets on a leash while mounted. Pet owners are solely responsible for any damages, claims, losses, or actions resulting from their pet behaviors. **Pet owners are required to clean up after their pets in all areas including barns and RV parking.** Pet owners failing to comply with this rule may be subject to penalty under Chapters 6 and 7, as well as the issuance of warning cards (GR1301.6)

Feed • Feed & hay are not available from the facility. Used bedding must be deposited in the manure dumps supplied.

Food • Food will be available on the show grounds. Check concessions for hours of operation. Absolutely no outside food and beverages allowed inside the First Interstate Bank Center. No alcohol permitted anywhere on DCFE property.

Haul-in/Trailer fee • All horses hauling in to show a single day may purchase a day stall at a cost of \$75. Day stall rental is from 7AM to the end of that day's show. **You may show out of your trailer at this show at a cost of \$30 per day. Please park in the designated "haul-in" area.**

Motorized Vehicles • Minors who do not have a valid driver's license which allows them to operate a motorized vehicle in the state in which they reside will not be permitted to operate a motorized vehicle of any kind, including, but not limited to, golf carts, motorcycles, scooters, or farm utility vehicles, on the competition grounds of licensed competitions. Minors who have a valid temporary license may operate the above-described motorized vehicles as long as they are accompanied by an adult with a valid driver's license. The parent/legal guardian or individual who signs the entry blank as a parent or guardian of a minor operating a motorized vehicle in violation of this rule are solely responsible for any damages, claims, losses or actions resulting from that operation. Violations of this rule will be cause for penalties against those responsible for the child committing the offense. Wheelchairs and other mobility assistance devices for individuals with disabilities are exempt from this rule. The unsafe use of personal electronic transport devices, as determined by the competition officials and management in their sole discretion, that do not require a driver's license to operate, including but not limited to segways, hover boards, and single wheeled scooters is prohibited on competition grounds. Operating such devices in areas where people gather may be deemed "unsafe use" if there is a risk of harm to others. If the operator of the device is a minor, the parent/legal guardian or individual who signs the entry blank as a parent or guardian of a minor operating the device in violation of this rule is accountable and may be subject to penalties. Wheelchairs and other mobility assistance devices for individuals with disabilities are exempt from this rule. *(updated 2/2024)*

Non-Competing Horses on the show grounds • Horses not entered in the show will be allowed on the show grounds. These horses must have an individually assigned stall (not shared) and be listed on Stabling Request form. Fill out the official entry form, sign the back of the entry form in all mandatory places and include a signed liability release form.

Outside / Exhibitor Alcohol • No alcoholic beverages are permitted on the premises of DCFE unless served by the official liquor license holder. Please refrain from using glass containers anywhere on the facility grounds.

Parking • All vehicles must be kept in designated parking areas. Trailers may be pulled to the barns to load and unload. All aisles and roadways around barns must be kept open due to fire regulations. Owners will be asked to move vehicles or risk towing and/or fines. No vehicles allowed to be parked in the barns at any time.

RV/Camper Hook Ups • **Reservations are open.** All reservations for RV spaces will be made through the Expo Center RV Park via their website <https://app.fireflyreservations.com/Reserve/Property/ExpoCenterRVParkOregon?holdExpired=False>. Use group code **25Arabian**. Pet owners are required to clean up after their pets in all areas including barns and RV parking.

MEMBERSHIP REQUIREMENTS

USEF MEMBERSHIP STATEMENT



Life, senior active and junior active members shall be eligible to participate in all classes at Regular Competitions, Eventing Competitions at the Modified Level or above and Combined Driving Competitions at the Advanced Level, Dressage, Reining and Vaulting Competitions and Endurance Rides. A non-member may participate as a handler, rider, driver, owner, lessee, or agent at Regular Competitions, Eventing Competitions, Dressage Competitions, Reining Competitions and Combined Driving Competitions upon payment of a Show Pass fee. Participants in the following classes are exempted from the Requirements of this rule: 1) leadline; 2) exhibitions; 3) games and races; 4) classes for 4-H members;

5) walk trot and academy classes (academy classes are classes limited to horses used regularly in a lesson program); 6) USDF introductory level tests, pas de deux and quadrille classes; 7) assistant handlers in Dressage Sport Horse Breeding classes (USEF update 9/23)

Amateur Certification • Only active Federation members may obtain amateur certification. Every person who has reached his/her 18th birthday and competes in classes for amateurs under Federation rules must possess current amateur certification issued by the Federation. Only active Federation members may obtain amateur certification, Amateur cards are no longer available for non-members. Any person who has not reached his/her 19th birthday is an amateur and does not require amateur certification. An amateur continues to be such until he/she has received a change in status from the Federation. There is no fee for amateur certification for Senior Active or Life Members. Refer to GR1306 & GR1307.

Canadian Exhibitors: EC Sport License holders in good standing and with a Gold or Platinum Sport License (FEI Disciplines); Bronze or Silver (Eventing); or Bronze, Silver, Gold, or Platinum Sport License (non-FEI disciplines and breeds) will be given a USEF Competing Membership at no cost for the purpose of competing in USEF-licensed competitions. For information about obtaining a USEF Competition membership, EC Sport License holders contact memberservices@usef.org. You will be issued a USEF number. Use this number on your entry form. USEF rules for amateur status apply for all competitions licensed by USEF. Individuals holding dual memberships (both USEF and EC) must complete the education requirements for both National Federations. All USEF Competing Members who are 18 years of age or older must annually complete the SafeSport Training provided by the U.S. Center for Safe Sport before being allowed to compete.



Farm/Business Owners: If a horse(s) is owned by a farm or any other entity, at least one of the Farm/Business's owners, must also **be a Federation Senior Active Competing Member in good standing. See GR201.** (12/01/24)

USEF Non-Member Participation • <https://www.usef.org/faqs/usef-show-pass> The rules have changed. If the competition cannot verify membership information, the exhibitor will be required to complete a Show Pass form online with usef.org and pay a non-refundable fee. Eligible exhibitors are prohibited from obtaining more than one (1) Show Pass per competition year. Purchase of a Show Pass fee does NOT allow a competitor to show in amateur classes. Walk/trot only riders are exempt. (12/22)

AHA MEMBERSHIP STATEMENT

EACH COMPETITOR (THIS INCLUDES AT LEAST ONE RECORDED OWNER AND ALL TRAINERS, DRIVERS, RIDERS, HALTER HANDLERS, COACHES AND THE PERSON(S) SIGNING THE ENTRY BLANK) IN AN ARABIAN HORSE ASSOCIATION RECOGNIZED ARABIAN DIVISION, AT THE TIME OF ENTRY INTO A COMPETITION, MUST SUBMIT A COPY OF A VALID AHA MEMBERSHIP/COMPETITION CARD, JOIN AHA OR PAY AN AHA SINGLE EVENT MEMBERSHIP FEE PER COMPETITOR. WHEN AN AGENT SIGNS FOR THE OWNER AT AN AHA RECOGNIZED COMPETITION, BOTH THE OWNER AND AGENT MUST BE MEMBERS OF AHA OR PAY THE AHA SINGLE EVENT MEMBERSHIP. SINGLE EVENT MEMBERSHIP IS NOT ACCEPTABLE AT AHA REGIONAL OR NATIONAL COMPETITIONS. EXHIBITORS IN WALK-TROT CLASSES ARE EXEMPT FROM AHA MEMBERSHIP REQUIREMENTS AT QUALIFYING COMPETITIONS BUT MUST HAVE AN AHA MEMBERSHIP WITH COMPETITION CARD AT AHA REGIONAL AND NATIONAL COMPETITIONS. EXHIBITORS IN LEAD LINE CLASSES OR PARENTS/GUARDIANS SIGNING FOR MINORS ARE EXEMPT FROM AHA MEMBERSHIP REQUIREMENTS. (BOD 5/12)



AHA Competition Card Requirements • All riders, drivers, owners, agents and handlers who exhibit horses in the show ring or sign the entry form as the responsible party for any individual's horses at the show must be AHA COMPETITION level members with competition cards. ***If the recorded owner is an entity (Farm, Ranch, Syndicate, etc.) it must have a current AHA Business membership.*** AHA does not permit Single Event Memberships at AHA Regional Championship Shows. AHA COMPETITION membership is required for all, including walk/trot riders. Lead Line or Parent/Guardian signing for minors are exempt.

Amateur Owner Classes • Horses entered in amateur owner and junior owner classes must be registered in the name of the competitor or a member of the competitor's family, as defined by USEF Rules. Horses registered in a farm/ranch/syndicate/ partnership/corporation name may be shown in Amateur Owner classes provided the family is the sole owner of the farm or entity. The sale of a horse does not eliminate this registration requirement. Every competitor must be an amateur and the owner, or an amateur member of the owner's family. Leased horses are not eligible. (Contracts of Sale or Bill of Sale will not be accepted in Owner Classes.)

Amateur Owner "Family" Definition • For ownership by the same family, the term family includes the following: spouse, parent, stepparent, child, stepchild, brother, sister, half brother and sister, aunt, uncle, niece, nephew, stepbrother and sister, grandparents and grandchildren, and in-laws of the same relation as stated above. Family also includes a cohabitant, a member of a couple who live together and have an intimate relationship without being married.

UNRELATED OWNERS IN OWNER CLASSES – For the purposes of showing in Junior Owner and Amateur Owner classes, two non-related owners will now be able to co-own a horse and show in owner classes provided the following rules are followed. Ownership **MUST** be an **AND** relationship and not an **OR** relationship. **No family member of a professional may enter into this relationship.** "Non-family owners" are defined as two distinct individuals who are not related as family as defined by US Equestrian or Equestrian Canada. The horse must be registered with one of the five Registries in US or Canada or another approved Registry. Family members of these two co-owners are **NOT** permitted to show in Owner classes. Both co-owners must be members of USEF or EC and hold valid amateur cards. Co-ownership is limited to two distinct individuals (no farms or business entities). A horse can only be in (1) one non-related Co-ownership per show season – if a co-ownership is terminated, another coownership cannot be entered into for that horse until the next year. An individual can only enter into (2) two distinct non-related co-ownerships at any one time. Show management may deny horses in this relationship entry into AO/JO classes with payout in excess of \$2,500. Please see **USEF AR110.4.e** for complete requirements and limitations.

Admission to the Arena and Paddock Area • No person will be allowed in the ring except participants in the class, licensed officials, assistants, and show photographer. Properly attired attendants will be allowed in the ring only after being called by the judge, ringmaster, or announcer. There shall be no conduct in the paddock area which disturbs or creates a hazard to horses, handlers, or spectators.

Attention Competitors • Each competitor is responsible for supplying management with correct association numbers (USEF, Equine Canada, AHA) for horse, owner, rider/driver/handler, trainer and coach before the day(s) of the competition. The scores of competitors who fail to supply correct numbers may not be counted toward national awards and breed association programs.

Awards of Prize Money • Every effort will be made to have checks available in the awards room during the posted hours. Checks must be signed for and everyone who receives a payout will need to complete a W-9 in order to receive their check regardless of the amount. Checks will be void after 60 days. **Region 4 Futurity classes:** Net money received from nominations will be allocated for prize money. Futurity Nominations are credited toward specific class entered.

ABS Sweepstakes classes: All prize money will be distributed by AHA.

Awards of Trophies and Ribbons • The awards room is located in the Sports Arena Building. The hours of operation will be posted on the door for your convenience. Placings are not final until the judge's cards and score sheets have been publicly posted. Once results are confirmed and posted, awards may be picked up and signed for at the awards room. Unclaimed awards will not be mailed.

A full Top Five will be awarded regardless of the number of entries in a class. However, only awards made to the top 50% of the class (rounded up and not to exceed 5 awards) will receive Arabian Breeders Sweepstakes payouts, AHA Horse Achievement Awards, Amateur Achievement Awards, High Point Horse Achievement Awards, High Point Amateur Achievement Awards and Distance Award points. All Top Five Awards will qualify for the corresponding national championship.

Region 4 Championship Classes: Champion – Award, Champion Ribbon, Garland. Reserve Champion – Award, Reserve Champion Ribbon. Entire Top 5 will receive Top 5 award and ribbon. ABS Sweepstakes ribbons will be awarded to enrolled horses in ABS Sweepstakes classes.

Regional ABS Yearling Halter Classes – Top Ten ribbons to 10th. Champion – Award, Champion Ribbon, Garland. Reserve Champion – Award, Reserve Champion Ribbon.

Region 4 Futurity Classes: Champion –Silver Belt Buckle, Award, Champion Ribbon, Garland. Reserve Champion – Award, Reserve Champion Ribbon. Entire Top 5 will receive Top 5 award and ribbon. **Prize Money will not be paid until a W-9 is delivered to the show treasurer**

Call for classes • Due to unforeseeable problems with any mechanical device, the public address system must be considered a courtesy. It is the exhibitors' responsibility to follow how quickly classes are progressing and to promptly present themselves when the gate person calls for their class.

RULES & GENERAL INFORMATION

Changes, Cancellation or Division of classes • Management reserves the right to make changes of arenas, judges or class order to facilitate time schedule and conditions for betterment of the Show. The Show Committee reserves the right to cancel, combine, or divide any classes or make any scheduling changes necessary. All changes will be posted on the Announcement Board at the office. Any performance championship that reaches **40** entries competing will be shown as a semifinal class with horses selected by the judges for final competition. ***The AATR Ranch Horse Rail, Ranch Horse Riding, Showmanship & Western Horsemanship classes have been split by age into 19-49 and 50 & Over. If any of those splits has fewer than 5 entries, the two age groups for that class will be combined and run as one regional class.***

AAOTR**/JOTR** Reining, Country, English, Hunter, and Western Pleasure classes: At the close of entries, the aforementioned classes will be split into age groups by rider age as equally as possible providing each group split results in a class of at least nine (9) entries. Exhibitors: Please put your DOB on the entry form in the space provided. All splits will be run in the same section as the AAOTR**/JOTR** class is scheduled. Splits will be posted the day before the class.

Change of Horse in Showmanship/Equitation Classes • Please have all changes made by 7PM the night prior to the class. If the draw order has been set, exhibitors with horse changes will stay as assigned.

Discipline • Exhibitors are advised that any act of discourtesy or disobedience to staff or officials of this show on part of the owner, exhibitor, agent, lessee, trainer, groom, rider, driver, handler, or family of the person participating in the show, will disqualify the horse from adjudication. Management reserves the right to remove a horse or any person from the show without being liable for compensation or damages.

Disputes not covered by the rules • Should any question or dispute arise not provided for in the governing rules of USEF and AHA, the same shall be referred to the Show Commission whose decision shall be final.

Drug and medication rule • Refer to USEF Chapter 4, The official Medication Report Form is now on line at: <https://competitions.usef.org/drugs-and-meds/medication-report-form/usef>.

Equitation Music • Exhibitors in Saddle Seat Equitation will be allowed to submit their own music selection for their regional championship class. Music requests (compact discs or digital media accepted) must be submitted to the show announcer before 7pm the night prior to the day their class is held.

Gate Hold • When a gate hold is requested by an exhibitor, such request will be made to the Paddock Master prior to the close of judging of the class immediately before the class requiring the gate hold. The reason for the request should be stated. The gate-hold will be a maximum of three (3) minutes. An appropriate warning will be given to all exhibitors if there is a gate hold in effect. When horses are competing collectively, if the first horse does not enter the in-gate ready to participate within one minute from when the class is called into the ring, a warning is issued. Exhibitors have one additional minute to start the steady stream of horses into the in-gate. If no horses have entered the gate at the conclusion of the additional one minute, the gate will be closed, and the class is deemed concluded. Once the first horse has entered the in-gate, a steady stream of horses must be maintained. See AR 107.1

Judges • The Show Commission reserves the right to substitute a judge for one who is officially designated.

Leveling Program (Select, Choice, Elite & Primetime Classes) • A rider may now choose to ride any and all levels at or above their given level but cannot ride below their designated level. For Example, if you are a Select Hunter Pleasure Rider, you will be able to ride in Hunter Pleasure Select AATR, Hunter Pleasure Choice AATR and, if you own the horse, Hunter Pleasure AAOTR. You can find your appropriate "level" by clicking on "Horse/Rider Points and Competition Records" from the AHA website member home page. Look for the access link labeled "Leveling Points". The view is broken into various sections, i.e., Hunter, Western, and Saddle Seat. You can use the summary at the bottom of the page along with the "leveling chart" to determine your level for the appropriate class. **It is the rider's responsibility to enter the correct level.** If you have questions about your level you are encouraged to contact AHA directly for verification 303.696.4500, option 4

SELECT RIDERS may enter any and all classes at this show: Open, AAOTR AATR, ATR, Choice/Elite.

Order of go • All Breeding/Gelding In-Hand classes will be oldest to youngest, including post entries. All working western, equitation pattern classes and showmanship classes will have a posted order of go a minimum of twenty-four (24) hours at Regional Championships. All "orders of go" will be posted on the Announcement Board at the Show Office and given to the Paddock Master not less than one hour prior to the start of that class. Accommodation may be made in the case of class conflicts.

Scoring Systems • All Regional Cutting, Reining, Reined Cow, Working Cow & Ranch Horse Riding classes will be judged by a single judge. Regional Trail classes will be judged by a single judge, using the AHA Trail scoring system. The "Comparative system (MOS)" will be used for all Breeding/Gelding In-Hand classes. All Halter classes will use the "In The Ring" class procedure. Performance Halter horses will be judged using the Arabian Performance Halter Score Card. The scorecards will be turned into placings and in turn, run through the Majority Opinion System (MOS) to determine the Champion, Reserve Champion and Top Five. The AHA approved Majority Opinion System (MOS) will be used for all other classes.

Region 4 Performance Futurities Entries will show and be judged under Futurity rules and applicable class specifications for junior horses as set forth in the Arabian division of the USEF rule book and will utilize MOS scoring. See complete rules on the website.

Show Office Hours • The horse show office will be open **Monday, June 26, 2025, from 9AM to 7PM**; thereafter from one hour before the first class until one-half hour after the last class of the day. Stallions • May be shown in any class except classes for Walk/Trot 10 & Under and Lead Line.

Sweepstakes Classes (ABS) • (excluding AHA Breeders Sweepstakes Yearling classes) are open to all horses, however, only horses enrolled in the (ABS) Arabian Breeders Sweepstakes program will earn payouts.



For and in consideration of United States Equestrian Federation, Inc. dba US Equestrian (“USEF”) allowing me, the undersigned, to participate in any capacity (including as a rider, driver, handler, vaulter, longeur, lessee, owner, agent, coach, official, trainer or volunteer) in a USEF sanctioned, licensed or approved event or activity, including but not limited to equestrian clinics, practices, shows, competitions and related or incidental activities and _____ (“USEF Event” or “USEF Events”); I, for myself, and on behalf of my spouse, children, heirs and next of kin, and any legal and personal representatives, executors, administrators, successors,, and assigns, hereby agree to and make the following contractual representations pursuant to this Agreement (the “Agreement”):

A. RULES AND REGULATIONS: I hereby agree that I have read, understand, and agree to be bound by all applicable Federation Bylaws, rules, and policies including the USEF Safe Sport Policy and Minor Athlete Abuse Prevention Policies (MAAPP) as published at www.usef.org, as amended from time to time.

B. ACKNOWLEDGMENT OF RISK: I knowingly, willingly, and voluntarily acknowledge the inherent risks associated with the sport of equestrian and know that horseback riding and related equestrian activities are inherently dangerous, and that participation in any USEF Event involves risks and dangers including, without limitation, the potential for serious bodily injury (including broken bones, head or neck injuries), sickness and disease (including communicable diseases), trauma, pain & suffering, permanent disability, paralysis and death; loss of or damage to personal property (including my mount & equipment) arising out of the unpredictable behavior of horses; exposure to extreme conditions and circumstances; accidents involving other participants, event staff, volunteers or spectators; contact or collision with other participants and horses, natural or manmade objects; adverse weather conditions; facilities issues and premises conditions; failure of protective equipment (including helmets); inadequate safety measures; participants of varying skill levels; situations beyond the immediate control of the USEF Event organizers and competition management; and other undefined, not readily foreseeable and presently unknown risks and dangers (“Risks”).

AHA ASSUMPTION OF RISK, RELEASE AND INDEMNIFICATION This document waives very important legal rights. Read it carefully before signing.

In consideration for AHA permitting me to participate in this Competition, and by signing the entry blank, I agree as follows:

I AGREE that I choose to participate voluntarily in this Competition, as a rider, driver, handler, lessee, owner, agent, coach, trainer, junior exhibitor, or as a parent or guardian of a junior exhibitor. **I AM FULLY AWARE AND ACKNOWLEDGE THAT HORSE SPORTS AND PARTICIPATION IN THIS COMPETITION INVOLVE SERIOUS RISK OF HARM INCLUDING, BUT NOT LIMITED TO, RISKS OF ACCIDENT, SERIOUS BODILY INJURY, INCLUDING DEATH, BROKEN BONES, HEAD INJURIES, TRAUMA, PAIN, AND SUFFERING, AND PROPERTY DAMAGE. I ASSUME ALL RISKS OF HARM TO ME, MY HORSE OR MY PROPERTY.**

I AGREE as a Horse Show Participant (or Parent/Guardian of Participant if a minor) to waive all claims which may otherwise arise from, including but not limited to infectious bacteria, viruses, fungi/mold, parasites, or other agents which may be present at the Horse Show (and most other outdoor locations) and can cause infection in humans, as well as in animals.

By signing below as a parent or guardian of a junior exhibitor, I consent to the child's participation and agree to all of the above provisions, and further agree to assume all of the obligations of this AHA Assumption of Risk, Release and Indemnification personally and on behalf of the child.

This AHA Assumption of Risk, Release and Indemnification is governed by the Laws of the State of Colorado and is intended to be interpreted as broadly as possible. I agree that exclusive jurisdiction and venue (place) for any legal action against AHA, its officers, directors, employees, volunteers, or agents shall be in the local district courts or the federal court of the State of Colorado. If any part of this agreement is determined to be unenforceable, all other parts shall remain effect.
