Distance (Endurance and Competitive)

2022 was a mixed season for endurance. We had a full slate of rides and reintroduced CTR (Competitive Trail Ride - aka "endurance lite") to the NW region. Lucie Hess has been coming out the last several years to stir up interest and get riders qualified for last week's AHA Distance Nationals in Gooding, ID. 4 of the 6 riders who completed the CTR were from region 4, one from II and one from MT. My horse, Ramsey BD+/, was Reserve Champion Purebred in the CTR. I'm committed to getting more involved in CTR because it's the safe, sane, smart way to get new horses started without them developing "race brain" and prevent overriding good horses early in their development. I don't have many other numbers, but there was, of course, a good showing overall from region 4. 29 horses, total, started on the 100. 14 finished- it was a hard ride. There were national champions, Tevis winners, and some big endurance names there. That's a huge number for a 100 mile ride.

When I arrived at the Distance Nationals, I noticed banners from other regions but none from region 4, which was a bit embarrassing. However, Dewayne Brown was also there and told me he had just discovered a Region 4 banner in his stuff, but he didn't bring it with him. I will be getting that from him and have it for future Region 4 and Distance Nationals when it comes back closer this way. I also noticed that there was a lot of sponsorships by regions and finally found a small mention of region 4 sponsoring some awards, but there was never any other mention of it or announcement. Since the ride was held in region 4, I do think we should have been more prominent. I didn't hear anything about region sponsorships, and maybe that's a miss on my part, but when it comes back this way again, I would like us to step up more. And since it's beneficial to all of region 4, I don't think it should come out of just the endurance budget.
