Endurance/CTR Sign up by May 1 to start counting your yearly points! Region 4 has added a new endurance/CTR category to their High Point Jackpot!

- The Jackpot is open to all registered AHA pure, half, or Anglo Arabs completing AERC endurance rides and/or CTR in Region 4 (Oregon and southern ID). Each nominated horse completing any of the Region 4 endurance rides/CTR in the current ride year will be eligible for a cash award. The Region 4 Championship ride/CTR is not part of this award system, just the regular rides and CTR. This year, CTR, LDs, and endurance are all counted the same.
- 2. The cost is \$25 to enter and all money collected is paid out. There are additional contributions of over \$1,000 to sweeten the whole pot. The more endurance riders who sign up the bigger our share of the pot is. This year only because of our late start, distance riders have until May 1 to sign up for the April rides to count. After that Region 4 rides count *from the time you sign-up*. Registration forms are on the Region 4 website, AHARegion4.com, and have to be mailed to Barb Garcia, whose address is on the form, Region 4, <u>NOT</u> to Carlene Benson. All points go to the horse regardless of who the rider is but *every rider needs an AHA competition card*.
- 3. Riders/owners do NOT need to be members of a Region 4 club to participate or live in Region 4, but *all riders need an AHA competition card for the points to be recorded*.
- Points are calculated from ride results posted on the AHA website. Points are calculated as follows: 1st= 5 points, 2nd= 4, 3rd= 3, 4th= 2, 5th= 1.

Your competition is the other endurance horses signed up for this distance category.

5. Year end disbursements will be made to the owner on the entry form in the following amounts for each category with entries:

First Place35% (of the total pool available in this category – endurance/CTR)Second place25%Third Place20%Fourth Place10%Fifth Place10%be no money carried forward from year to year. In the event that there are fewer

There will be no money carried forward from year to year. In the event that there are fewer than five entries in the endurance/CTR category, the pool will be disbursed on a pro-rata basis according to the actual number of entries in the category. In order to earn prize money, the entry must earn at least one point in the category. The full amount of funds collected will be paid out in awards. There is also added money that will be applied to each category based on the number of entries in that category. The first place horse in each category will be eligible to have a picture posted on the Region 4 website. AHARegion4.com

6. In case of a tie, the money allotted for the tied entries will be split evenly.
