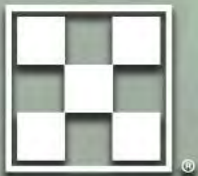

**Entries** • See the table “DATES, DEADLINES, CANCELLATIONS & CHANGES.” If the entry is **NOT RECEIVED BY** this date, it will be considered a late entry and post entry fees will be added to your entry. **By signing and submitting an entry to this show, it is your intent to show and agree to our rules. You agree to pay all fees due and understand that refunds will not be made except by the policy stated.**

This show will accept bank checks by mail and PayPal only. (no credit cards will be processed)

You will still need to mail or e-mail the following:

- The USEF Waiver of Liability for EACH person on your entry form; one form per person.
- The Oregon Horse Center Waiver of Liability for EACH person **who is on the grounds** at this show.
- If leasing or purchasing horse on contract and showing under your ownership, then send a copy of the agreement.

**Entry Cancellations, Refunds & Substitutions** • To encourage early entries,

1. If an exhibitor vets out a horse between the close of entries and **before 7pm May 19th**, and brings a replacement horse, the post entry for such regional class will be waived.
2. Absolutely no requests for refunds for any reason will be considered unless the request with supporting documentation is in the show secretary's hand prior to **7PM May 19, 2026**, for consideration by the Show Commission. Such a refund will include all fees minus a \$50 cancellation fee.
3. After **7PM May 19, 2026**, no refunds will be made except in the case of unusual situations. The Show Commission reserves the right to review these situations case by case upon receipt of a written request with supporting documentation before the end of the show..
4. In the event of show cancellation due to severe weather or other emergency, refunds of entry fees, less a \$25 processing fee, will be made upon written request by the exhibitor within 30 days of the cancellation.
5. No substitution of horses will be permitted except as provided in USEF rules.

**Entry Confirmation** • Will be sent via e-mail to the legible email address on your entry. Please check the acknowledgement for accuracy and requests for additional information and/or monies to avoid incomplete entry charges and delays in the show office when you arrive at the show. **All communication with exhibitors, owners and trainers will be via email. To make sure that you are getting all of our information, put your email address on your entry form or email it to us at [horseshownumber@gmail.com](mailto:horseshownumber@gmail.com).** Various correspondence may be sent via email to the email address that is currently on file with AHA. If you need to update your email address, you can log on to your AHA account on the AHA website, or you can call the AHA office at 303-696-4500 and they can update the address for you.

**Entry Payment** • Make checks payable in US Funds to **Region 4 AHA**. Show Management cannot accept an entry unless it is accompanied by a valid check, money order, or PayPal for the full amount of the entry costs, including entry fees, drug fee, and AHA and USEF non-member fees. Full balance owed on entries is due at time of processing of entries. Entries received without a valid check, money order or PayPal will not be processed until payment is received and will be subject to post entry penalties if payment is submitted after close of entries.

**OPEN CHECKS** - At check-in, before show numbers will be released, all exhibitors will be required to leave an open check, separate from their entries to cover any additional entries, fines or penalties incurred at the show. Check will be used to settle monies due. International exhibitors must draw all checks on U.S. Funds.

**Refusal of Entries:** • The Region 4 AHA Board of Delegates has directed that entries must be refused from anyone who has an outstanding obligation to a Region 4 affiliated club, show, or contracted services. Management reserves the right to hold classes conditionally, or cancel the entries of any contestant, as stated in USEF Rules. The commission reserves the right to remove any horse or person from the show who has shown an objectionable attitude or behavior towards its management, or previous unsportsmanlike behavior, without being liable for compensation or damages.

**Returned Checks & Denied PayPal Transaction** • Dishonored checks **and/or declined PayPal Transaction** will incur a \$50 charge per domestic failure (\$75 per International check). Payments will not be processed through the bank a second time. To retain entries, fees plus penalty must be paid by US money order, cashier's check, cash, or alternate PayPal within 7 days of notification or post entries will be applied to your entry. In the event a check is returned or PayPal denied by the bank after the completion of the show, it will be managed following USEF GR913.

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**Admission to the Arena and Paddock Area ●** No person will be allowed in the ring except participants in the class, licensed officials, assistants, and show photographer. Properly attired attendants will be allowed in the ring only after being called by the judge, ringmaster, or announcer. There shall be no conduct in the paddock area which disturbs or creates a hazard to horses, handlers, or spectators.

**AHA MEMBERSHIP STATEMENT ●** Each competitor (this includes at least one recorded owner and all trainers, drivers, riders, halter handlers, coaches and the person(s) signing the entry blank) in an Arabian Horse Association recognized Arabian division, at the time of entry into a competition, must submit a copy of a valid AHA membership/competition card, join AHA or pay an AHA single event membership fee per competitor. When an agent signs for the owner at an AHA recognized competition, both the owner and agent must be members of AHA or pay the AHA single event membership. Single event membership is not acceptable at AHA regional or national competitions. Exhibitors in walk-trot classes are exempt from AHA membership requirements at qualifying competitions but must have an AHA membership with competition card at AHA regional and national competitions. Exhibitors in lead line classes or parents/guardians signing for minors are exempt from AHA membership requirements. (BOD 5/12)

**AHA Competition Card Requirements ●** All riders, drivers, owners, agents, and handlers who exhibit horses in the show ring or sign the entry form as the responsible party for any individual's horses at the show must be AHA **competition** level members with competition cards. **If the recorded owner is an entity (Farm, Ranch, Syndicate, etc.) it must have a current AHA Business membership.** AHA does not permit Single Event Memberships at AHA Regional Championship Shows. AHA **competition** membership is required for all, including walk/trot riders. Lead Line or Parent/Guardian signing for minors are exempt from AHA Competition Card requirements.

**Amateur Owner Classes ●** Horses entered in amateur owner and junior owner classes must be registered in the name of the competitor or a member of the competitor's family, as defined by USEF Rules. Horses registered in a farm/ranch/syndicate/partnership/corporation name may be shown in Amateur Owner classes provided the family is the sole owner of the farm or entity. The sale of a horse does not drop this registration requirement. Every competitor must be an amateur and the owner, or an amateur member of the owner's family. Leased horses are not eligible. (Contracts of Sale or Bill of Sale will not be accepted in Owner Classes.)

**Alcohol ●** Outside or Exhibitor alcoholic beverages are not allowed on the premises of OHC unless served by the official liquor license holder. Please refrain from using glass containers anywhere on the facility grounds.

**Amateur Certification ●** Every adult amateur contestant that has reached their 19th birthday as of December 1 of the previous calendar year must hold amateur status. 1. Every person who has reached their 19th birthday and competes in classes for amateurs under Federation rules must possess current amateur certification issued by the Federation. This certification must be available for inspection, or the competitor must have lodged with the competition secretary, at least one hour prior to such class. An application form for such certification may be obtained online from the Federation. Certification will be issued only on receipt of the application properly signed and is revocable at any time for cause. 2. Regardless of one's equestrian skills and/or accomplishments, a person is an amateur for all competitions conducted under Federation rules who after their 19th birthday has not engaged in any activities which would make them a professional. See GR1306 for listing of activities.

**Amateur Owner "Family" Definition ●** For ownership by the same family, the term family includes the following: spouse, parent, stepparent, child, stepchild, brother, sister, half brother and sister, aunt, uncle, niece, nephew, stepbrother and sister, grandparents and grandchildren, and in-laws of the same relation as stated above. Family also includes a cohabitant; a member of a couple who live together and have an intimate relationship without being married.

**Unrelated Owners in Owner Classes-** For the purposes of showing in Junior Owner and Amateur Owner classes, two non-related owners will now be able to co-own a horse and show in owner classes provided the following rules are followed. Ownership **MUST** be an **AND** relationship and not an **OR** relationship. **No family member of a professional may enter into this relationship.** "Non-family owners" are defined as two distinct individuals who are not related as family as defined by US Equestrian or Equestrian Canada. The horse must be registered with one of the five Registries in US or Canada or another approved Registry. Family members of these two co-owners are **NOT** permitted to show in Owner classes. Both co-owners must be members of USEF or EC and hold valid amateur cards. Co-ownership is limited to two distinct individuals (no farms or business entities). A horse can only be in (1) one non-related Co-ownership per show season – if a co-ownership is terminated, another co-ownership cannot be entered into for that horse until the next year. An individual can only enter into (2) two distinct non-related co-ownerships at any one time.

**Arenas (Show & Warm Up) ●** There are three (3) arenas for your use. The main Silverado Show Arena is 285 x 116. The Logan Warm-Up Arena is 200 x 120, and the Emerald Warm-Up Arena is 200 x 100. Arenas are made up of a mixture of native soil and sand.

## RULES & GENERAL INFORMATION

**Attention Competitors** • Each competitor is responsible for supplying management with correct association numbers (USEF, Equine Canada, AHA) for horse; owner, rider/driver/handler, trainer, and coach before the day(s) of the competition. The scores of competitors who do not supply correct numbers may not be counted toward national awards and breed association programs.

**Awards of Prize Money** • Everyone who receives a payout will need to complete a W-9 form with correct information in order to receive their check regardless of the amount. **This is not negotiable.** Checks must be signed for and will be void after 60 days of issuance. Prize Money Payouts will be distributed as follows: Champion 50%, Reserve 20%, Balance of Top Five 10% each. Refer to futurity program for payout rules. Every effort will be made to have checks available in the office during the posted hours. **No W-9, no check.**

**Region 4 Futurity classes:** Net money received from nominations will be distributed for prize money along with purse contributions. Futurity Nominations are credited toward specific class entered. Winnings will be mailed to the address on the W-9 form received by the treasurer.

**ABS Sweepstakes classes:** All prize money will be distributed by AHA. Contact the AHA office at 303-696-4500 for more information.

**Awards of Trophies and Ribbons** • The awards room is found on the concourse by the Feed Room. The hours of operation will be posted for your convenience. Placings are not final until the judge's cards and score sheets have been publicly posted. Once results are confirmed and posted, awards may be picked up and signed for at the awards room. Bring your back number for verification. Unclaimed awards will not be mailed.

**A full Top Five will be awarded regardless of the number of entries in a class. However, only awards made to the top 50% of the class (rounded up and not to exceed 5 awards) will receive Arabian Breeders Sweepstakes payouts, AHA Horse Achievement Awards, Amateur Achievement Awards, High Point Horse Achievement Awards, High Point Amateur Achievement Awards and Distance Award points.**

**Region 4 Futurity Classes:** Champion –Silver Belt Buckle by Molly's Silver; Rose Blanket, Champion Ribbon & Award. Reserve Champion Red Rose Garland with plaque, Reserve Champion Ribbon & Award *donated by Modrich Family Trust.* – Balance of Top 5 - Custom Top Five ribbon. Top Five plaque upon request. **Futurity winnings will be mailed to the address on the W-9 form received by the treasurer.**

**Call for classes** • Due to unforeseeable problems with any mechanical device, the public address system must be considered a courtesy. It is the exhibitors' responsibility to follow how quickly classes are progressing and to promptly present themselves when the gate person calls for their class.

**Canadian Exhibitors:** EC Sport License holders in good standing and with a Gold or Platinum Sport License (FEI Disciplines); Bronze or Silver (Eventing); or Bronze, Silver, Gold, or Platinum Sport License (non-FEI disciplines and breeds) will be given a USEF Competing Membership at no cost for the purpose of competing in USEF-licensed competitions. For information about obtaining a USEF Competition membership, EC Sport License holders contact [memberservices@usef.org](mailto:memberservices@usef.org). You will be issued a USEF number. Use this number on your entry form. USEF rules for amateur status apply to all competitions licensed by USEF. Individuals holding dual memberships (both USEF and EC) must complete the education requirements for both National Federations. All USEF Competing Members who are 18 years of age or older must annually complete the SafeSport Training provided by the U.S. Center for Safe Sport before being allowed to compete.

**Changes, Cancellation or Division of classes** • Management reserves the right to make changes of arenas, judges, or class order to ease time schedule and conditions for betterment of the Show. Show Management reserves the right to cancel, combine, or divide any classes or make any scheduling changes necessary. All changes will be posted on the Announcement Board at the office. Any performance championship that reaches **40** entries competing will be shown as a semifinal class with horses selected by the judges for final competition.

**AAOTR\*\*/JOTR** Country, English, Hunter, Reining and Western Pleasure classes: At the close of entries, the aforementioned classes will be split into age groups by rider age as equally as possible providing each group split results in a class of at least nine (9) entries. Exhibitors: Please put your DOB on the entry form in the space provided. All splits will be run in the same section as the AAOTR\*\*/JOTR\*\* class is scheduled. Splits will be posted the day before the class.

**ATR** English, English Show Hack, Ranch Trail, Trail classes: At the close of entries, the aforementioned classes will be split into age groups by rider age JTR 18 & Under and ATR 19 & Over, providing each group split results in a class of at least five (5) entries. Exhibitors: Please put your DOB on the entry form in the space provided. All splits will be run in the same section as the ATR class is scheduled. Splits will be posted the day before the class.

**AATR** Ranch Horse Rail, Ranch Horse Riding classes have been split by age into 19-49 and 50 & Over. If any of those splits has fewer than 5 entries, the two age groups for that class will be combined and run as one regional class.

**Equitation\*\*** classes will be split when there are 2 equal age groups of 5 or more.

**Change of Horse in Showmanship/Equitation Classes** • Please have all changes made by 7PM the night prior to the class. If the draw order has been set, exhibitors with horse changes will stay in the order as assigned.

**Discipline** • Exhibitors are advised that any act of discourtesy or disobedience to staff or officials of this show on part of the owner, exhibitor, agent, lessee, trainer, groom, rider, driver, handler, or family of the person taking part in the show, will disqualify the horse from adjudication. Management reserves the right to remove a horse or any person from the show without being liable for compensation or damages.

## RULES & GENERAL INFORMATION

**Disputes not covered by the rules** • Should any question or dispute arise not provided for in the governing rules of USEF and AHA, the same shall be referred to the Show Commission whose decision shall be final.

**Dogs (& Other pets)** • Dogs are allowed on leash only and never in or near the boarding barns. If a dog is found off leash, **the lessee will be fined \$50 for the first offense.** If the same dog is found off leash again, the owner of the dog will have to remove the dog from the premises, and it will not be allowed to return. Exhibitors/participants must clean up after their dogs. **Any feces found on the event grounds after the event will be cleaned up at the rate of \$50 per instance and passed on to the exhibitor.** No dogs are allowed in the Feed Room Restaurant and in the case that a dog is considered to be a nuisance under ORS 609.095, the show must have the dog removed from the show grounds. Owners/handlers of dogs found off leash will be issued a USEF Yellow Card by the show steward.

**Drug and medication rule** • The drugs and medication rules contained in the USEF Rule Book will be enforced. Horses in competition will be subject to examination by a licensed veterinarian appointed by USEF. The veterinarian, with approval of the USEF, may appoint a technician to perform certain duties under USEF Rules. The examination may include physical, saliva, urine, blood tests or any other test or procedure at the discretion of said licensed veterinarian necessary to effectuate the purposes of this rule. These representatives must be treated with respect. All horses, (Halter, Performance and Equitation) will be charged \$25.00 per horse to defray the expenses of testing. CAUTION: Refusal to submit a horse for examination, whether in competition or not, or to cooperate with the veterinarian and technicians until the samples have been taken, constitutes a violation and subjects the person responsible to the penalties under the rules. The official Medication Report Form is to be filed electronically: <https://competitions.usef.org/drugs-and-meds/medication-report-form/usef>.

**Equitation Music** • Exhibitors in Saddle Seat Equitation will be allowed to submit their own music choice for their regional championship class. Music requests (compact discs or digital media accepted) must be given to the announcer before 7pm the night prior to their class.

**Farm/Business Owners** • If a horse(s) is owned by a farm or any other entity, at least one of the Farm/Business's owners, must also be a USEF Federation Senior Active Competing Member in good standing. See GR201. (12/01/24)

**Feed** • Feed & hay are not available from the facility. H & E Feeds is located ½ mile from OHC for any added needs. Contact H & E Feeds for preorders (541) 688-3214.

**Food** • Food will be available on the show grounds. The OHC Feed Room Restaurant will be open from 7am to 7pm daily

**Gate Hold** • When an exhibitor requests a gate hold, such request will be made to the Paddock Master prior to the close of judging of the class immediately before the class requiring the gate hold. The reason for the request should be stated. The gate hold will be a maximum of three (3) minutes. A suitable notice will be given to all exhibitors if there is a gate hold in effect. When horses are competing collectively, if the first horse does not enter the in-gate ready to participate within one minute from when the class is called into the ring, a notice is issued. Exhibitors have one added minute to start the steady stream of horses into the in-gate. If no horses have entered the gate at the conclusion of the additional one minute, the gate will be closed, and the class is deemed concluded. Once the first horse has entered the in-gate, a steady stream of horses must be maintained. See AR 107.1

**Haul-in/Trailer fee** • Exhibitors may show from their trailers at the fee of \$35.00 PER HORSE PER DAY. Every horse must pay a stall fee, daily stall fee, or a haul-in/trailer in fee. Horses on the grounds overnight must be stalled. *Please clean up your mess. Leave it nicer than you found it!*

**Judges** • The Show Commission reserves the right to substitute a judge for one who is officially designated.

**Leveling Program (Select, Choice, Elite & Primetime Classes)** • **A rider may now choose to ride any and all levels at or above their given level** but cannot ride below their designated level. For Example, if you are a Select Hunter Pleasure Rider, you will be able to ride in Hunter Pleasure Select AATR, Hunter Pleasure Choice AATR and, if you own the horse, Hunter Pleasure AAOTR. You can find your proper "level" by clicking on "Horse/Rider Points and Competition Records" from the AHA website member home page. Look for the access link labeled "Leveling Points." The view is broken into various sections, i.e., Hunter, Western, and Saddle Seat. You can use the summary at the bottom of the page along with the "leveling chart" to determine your level for the appropriate class. **It is the rider's responsibility to enter the correct level.** If you have questions about your level you are encouraged to contact AHA directly for verification (303) 696.4500, option 4.

**SELECT RIDERS may enter any and all classes at this show: Open, AAOTR AATR, ATR, Choice/Elite.**

**Non-Competing Horses on the show grounds** • A "Plus-One" horse is a horse brought to the show but not entered in any classes. A "Plus One" may be a training horse, a horse for sale or a babysitter to a competing horse. "Plus-One" horses are welcome at this show as long as they adhere to the same guidelines as competing horses. All horses on the grounds must complete a liability waiver at the show office, pay for stabling and a nominal fee for use of the facilities and liability insurance coverage. These horses must have an individually assigned stall (not shared) and be listed on Stabling Request form. Fill out the official entry form, sign the back of the entry form in all mandatory places, and include a signed liability release form.

## RULES & GENERAL INFORMATION

**Order of go** • All Breeding/Gelding In-Hand classes will be youngest to oldest, including post entries. All working western, equitation pattern classes and showmanship classes will have a posted order of go a minimum of twenty-four (24) hours at Regional Championships. All “orders of go” will be posted on the Announcement Board at the Show Office and given to the Paddock Master not less than one hour prior to the start of that class. Accommodation may be made in the case of class conflicts.

**Parking** • All vehicles must be kept in designated parking areas. Trailers may be pulled to the barns to load and unload. All aisles and roadways around barns must be kept open due to fire regulations. Owners will be asked to move vehicles or risk towing and/or fines. No vehicles are allowed to be parked in the barns at any time.

**RV/Camper Hook Ups:** • **Reservations are open.** Exhibitors may stay overnight in an RV, Trailer, or Camper in the designated RV spaces. Spaces are pre-assigned through OHC website. There are electrical hook-ups (limited water). Reserve your space at [www.oregonhorsecenter.com/where-to-stay](http://www.oregonhorsecenter.com/where-to-stay)

**Scoring Systems** • A single judge will judge all Reining classes. Regional Trail classes will be judged by a single judge, using the AHA Trail scoring system. All Ranch Riding classes will use the Three Judge System, with all scores used to determine the final score. The “Comparative system” (MOS) will be used for all Breeding/Gelding In-Hand classes. Performance Halter horses will be judged using the Arabian Performance Halter Score Card. The scorecards will be turned into placings and in turn, run through the Majority Opinion System (MOS) to determine the Champion, Reserve Champion and Top Five. The AHA approved Majority Opinion System (MOS) will be used for all other classes

**Region 4 Performance Futurities** Entries will show and be judged under Futurity rules and applicable class specifications for junior horses as set forth in the Arabian division of the USEF rule book and will use MOS scoring. All Ranch Riding classes will use the Three Judge System, with all scores used to determine the final score See complete rules on the website.

**Security** • Exhibitors are advised that it is their responsibility to secure valuables including their stall areas. The Region 4 AHA Championship Show and the Region 4 Arabian Horse Association, its members, agents, employees, and volunteers accept no responsibility for losses sustained or caused by any exhibitor.

**Sharps Containers for Medical Waste** • (needles, syringes, etc.) will be available in the show office and one in the barn aisles for every 50 stalls (GR1210.4) A \$100 fine per violation will be passed on to the violator for improper disposal of needles or other medical waste.

**Show Office Hours** • The horse show office will be open **Monday & Tuesday, from NOON to 7PM**; thereafter from one hour before the first class until one-half hour after the last class of the day. Trainers may schedule appointments. Show office phone is 360-949-9333, NO TEXTS, or email to: [horseshownumber@gmail.com](mailto:horseshownumber@gmail.com)

**Stabling** • There are 274 regular wooden stalls with full doors and 88 portable stalls (steel frame bars and solid puck board siding) available. Each horse must be assigned a separate stall. Horses must be placed in the stalls assigned. No changes will be allowed without the consent of the barn manager. **OHC will provide bulk shavings free of charge while they last.** Bagged Bedding may be purchased on your entry form. Other types of bedding or from outside sources are not allowed. There is a charge of \$25 per stall for any exhibitor found to be using bedding other than shavings. Every horse must pay a stall fee, daily stall fee, or a haul-in/trailer fee. Exhibitors wishing to be stabled together should send a stabling form **noting their requested barn neighbors.**

**Early arrivals/Late departures** • Early arrivals and Late departures must be pre-approved by Barn Manager. There will be \$25 per day, per stall and/or tack room early arrival or late departure charge.

**Patron Stabling** • Patrons will be assigned on a preferential basis before non-patrons. Priority for patrons will be based on patron seniority, degree of support and submission of current patron enrollment & stall request to Region 4 **by April 22, 2026.**

**Tents, Curtains, and Decorations** • Blocking stalls or crossing stall aisles with decorations or obstructions of any kind is not allowed. All lumber, nails, building materials, etc. must be removed. Failure to dispose of material will result in a minimum of \$100 fine or actual cost of clean-up to the person renting stalls. Landscape materials consisting of sod, bark dust and plants are excluded from clean up fine assessments.

**Stall Cleaning** – Manure dumping will be at the North and South corners of the show stall barn. Barrels are placed at the end of the aisles for trash . Deposit trash directly in barrels provided. Do not mix manure and other refuse. If you leave garbage or empty your water buckets in your stalls, you will be charged a \$50 clean-up fee per stall.

**Stallions** • May be shown in any class except classes for Walk/Trot 10 & Under and Lead Line.

**Sweepstakes Classes (ABS)** • (excluding AHA Breeders Sweepstakes Yearling classes) are open to all horses, however, only horses enrolled in the (ABS) Arabian Breeders Sweepstakes program will earn payouts from the Arabian Horse Association.

If you need to cancel any of your stalls, please do so 5 days prior to scheduled arrival. Any stalls not cancelled by

**USEF MEMBERSHIP STATEMENT** • Life, senior active and junior active members shall be eligible to participate in all classes at Regular Competitions, Eventing Competitions at the Modified Level or above and Combined Driving Competitions at the Advanced Level, Dressage, Reining and Vaulting Competitions and Endurance Rides. A non-member may participate as a handler, rider, driver, owner, lessee, or agent at Regular Competitions, Eventing Competitions, Dressage Competitions, Reining Competitions and Combined Driving Competitions upon payment of a Show Pass fee. Participants in the following classes are exempted from the Requirements of this rule: 1) leadline; 2) exhibitions; 3) games and races; 4) classes for 4-H members; 5) walk trot and academy classes (academy classes are classes limited to horses used regularly in a lesson program); 6) USDF introductory level tests, pas de deux and quadrille classes; 7) assistant handlers in Dressage Sport Horse Breeding classes (USEF GR901)

**USEF Non-Member Participation** • <https://www.usef.org/faqs/usef-show-pass> The rules have changed. If the competition cannot verify membership information, the exhibitor will be required to complete a Show Pass form online with usef.org and pay a non-refundable fee. Eligible exhibitors are prohibited from obtaining more than one (1) Show Pass per competition year. Purchase of a Show Pass fee does NOT allow a competitor to show in amateur classes. Walk/trot only riders are exempt. (12/22)

**USEF Participants** • USEF thanks you for participating in this competition and your support of USEF's continuous efforts to provide the safest environment possible for our athletes and other participants. 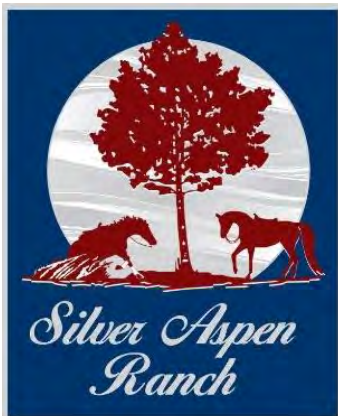

## REGIONAL WORKING WESTERN ALL-AROUND CHAMPION

### TERMS & CONDITIONS

The Regional Working Western All-Around Champion award demonstrates the athletic ability, versatility, and trainability of today's Arabian & HA/AA Working Western horse. To qualify for the All-Around Champion award a horse & rider combination must enter and show in at least three of the four listed disciplines at the same **Regional** show: REINING, WESTERN TRAIL, RANCH RIDING, and any CATTLE CLASS. There are four categories: ARABIAN OPEN, ARABIAN AMATEUR, HA/AA OPEN, and HA/AA AMATEUR.

- Only one (1) class from each discipline will count towards the final tabulation.
- Points are earned in individual classes at each Regional show and then combined to determine the All-Around Champion for that show.
- Points are assigned based on the number of entries in the class.
- Any classes designated as "Jr. Horse" count toward the Open category.
- Classes must be designated as "Amateur" to count towards the Amateur category. Classes designated as "Open" or "Jr. Horse" do not count toward the Amateur category even if ridden by an Amateur.
- There is no entry fee to compete for the All-Around Champion title. However, a completed form **MUST** be turned into the official Show Office before the start of the show to be eligible. Forms may also be submitted on-line to the AWWA at [WorkingWestern@gmail.com](mailto:WorkingWestern@gmail.com). **Forms must be received before the start of the show.**
- It is the responsibility of the exhibitor to complete and submit the form to the show office or on-line to AWWA to designate clearly which Working Western classes they intend to utilize for points in each discipline.

## AWWA RANCH DISCIPLINED RAIL PLEASURE ATR

AWWA is proud to introduce a new Ranch class to serve the needs of an expanding exhibitor base. The class is open to any age Arabian or HA/AA horse ridden by an Amateur who is properly entered in the Show.

The AWWA will provide the class awards to Champion, Reserve Champion, and a full Top 5. Prize money is determined and paid out by AWWA. The Owner must provide to AWWA a completed W9 form. The AWWA will issue prize money checks to Owner within 30 days of the completion of Show. Prize money checks must be cashed within 90 days of issued. Checks will be considered void after that time.

Entries will be shown and judged in accordance with the Ranch Rail Appointments and Conduct (AR242) as set forth in the Arabian Division of the USEF Rule Book, with a change in the Class Specifications noted in the FINALS CLASS PROCEDURE section listed below.

A three-judge MOS scoring system will be used.

If sections are required, they will run as standard Ranch Rail Pleasure classes (See AR243). Eight (8) horses will advance from each section to the finals.

A random order of go will be used for Finals to enter the arena.

### FINALS CLASS PROCEDURE:

The Finals of the AWWA Ranch Disciplined Rail Pleasure class is to show the ability of a well-trained Ranch Horse to be used as a work partner and companion. Horses should be willingly guided with smooth transitions and quality movements.

Final judging shall be based on the best overall ranch disciplined rail performance. The class is not a game, nor a fault and out elimination class. Horses must not

be over- worked. Safety of horse and riders are of first- priority.

1. Each horse enters the arena individually at the trot proceeding up centerline. At marker, exhibitors turn left and proceed down the long wall at an extended trot riding past the entry gate. Once past the gate each exhibitor will transition to the walk and find a place along the right-hand long wall to stand quietly as each exhibitor enters the arena.

2. When all exhibitors have performed the individual entry maneuver the call judge will work horses on the rail as a group at the walk, trot, and lope both directions of the ring. An extension of any gait may be called.

3. Exhibitors will be asked to perform additional work. Work may include, but it not limited to:

- a. Hand gallop
- b. Flying or Simple change of lead
- c. Halt & stand quietly on rail
- d. Side pass either to left or right
- e. Turn on hind quarters
- f. Turn on forehand
- g. Starting into lope from a halt
- h. Extension of any gait

4. Upon completion of rail work, horses will be lined-up side-by-side in center of arena. Individually, exhibitors will ride forward from line, turn a 360 in either direction, and then back into the original place in line.

The AWWA Ranch Discipline Rail Pleasure class will be offered at the 2026 Youth/Mid- Summer Nationals show in Oklahoma City, OK.

I AM FULLY AWARE AND ACKNOWLEDGE THAT HORSE SPORTS AND PARTICIPATION IN THIS COMPETITION INVOLVE SERIOUS RISK OF HARM INCLUDING, BUT NOT LIMITED TO, RISKS OF ACCIDENT, SERIOUS BODILY INJURY, INCLUDING DEATH, BROKEN BONES, HEAD INJURIES, TRAUMA, PAIN, AND SUFFERING, AND PROPERTY DAMAGE. I ASSUME ALL RISKS OF HARM TO ME, MY HORSE OR MY PROPERTY.

I AGREE as a Horse Show Participant (or Parent/Guardian of Participant if a minor) to waive all claims which may otherwise arise from, including but not limited to infectious bacteria, viruses, fungi/mold, parasites or other agents which may be present at the Horse Show (and most other outdoor locations) and can cause infection in humans, as well as in animals.

B.
