

Blackberry Boot Cuffs

Abbreviations

- pm: place marker
- itr: in the round
- rnd: round
- st(s): stitch or stitches
- rem: remain(ing)
- tbl: through back loop
- tog: together
- k: knit
- p: purl
- m3: make 3
- rep: repeat

Materials Needed

- 1 skein, divided, Lion Brand Comfy Cotton Blend (or 2 skeins if you're making several pair for gifts - can get 5-6 pair from 2 skeins)
- 47" US 7 circular needle
- US 9 circular or flat needle (for binding off)
- Darning needle
- Stitch marker (safety pin)
- Round counter
- Pen & paper for your notes.

1x1 Twisted Rib

*K1tbl, P1

M3 (aka Bobble)

K1, P1, K1 into next stitch

Blackberry Pattern

Rnd 1: Knit

Rnd 2: *M3, P3tog; rep from * to end

Rnd 3: Knit

Rnd 4: *P3tog, M3; rep from * to end

Casting on for 2-at-a-time cuffs:

Cast on a total of 64 sts per cuff, 32 sts per side, twice (one for each cuff). Begin 1x1 Twisted Rib pattern and knit for 35 rnds or about 5 1/2". Begin Blackberry pattern and knit for 20 rnds or about 3". Bind off loosely using size US 9 needles or size needed to bind off so the topper can stretch over your boots.
