# SEED STITCH COWL

**NOTE:** Gauge is important when determining how many stitches to cast on. Be sure to knit a gauge swatch with the yarn and needles you intend to use to make the project. This will help you determine if you need to make any adjustments to this pattern.

PM..... Place Marker(s)

itr..... in the round

st(s).... stitch(es)

tog ..... together

k..... knit

p..... purl

rnd(s)..round(s)

rep..... repeat

## **SUPPLIES**

Needle ..... US 7 – 4.5 mm 16" Circular (or length

needed)

Needle ..... US 9 - 5.5 mm for binding off

Stitch Markers

Darning Needle

Lion Brand, Comfy Cotton Blend, any color

Pen & Paper for your notes

# SIZES/CAST ONS

**4** 24" Circumference **Cast on:** 120 sts **Uses:** ½ - 1 ½ skeins; depending upon whether you choose the 24" x 10" cowl or the 24" x 24" Snood.

**4** 36" Circumference **Cast on:** 180 sts **Uses:** ½ - ¾ skeins: depends how wide you make it. I prefer 6 − 7 ½".

48" Circumference Cast on: 240 sts Uses: 3/4 - 1 skein; depends how wide you make it.

### **SEED STITCH PATTERN**

Odd Rnds: \*k1, p1; rep from \* to end

Even Rnds: \*p1, k1; rep from \* to end.

## **DIRECTIONS**

Cast on the desired number of sts to achieve one of the circumferences listed above. PM every 20 sts while casting on, be sure to use a different color marker where the round starts and ends. Be careful not to twist the join. Begin Seed Stich Pattern and knit in pattern until desired width is achieved. Bind off with US 9 needles, or use a stretchy bind off technique, if preferred.
