

Awake Night Care Worker

Job Title: Awake Night Care Worker

Job Overview

The Awake Night-Residential Care Worker provides critical overnight care and security for residents in a group home setting. The role ensures the safety and well-being of residents during nighttime hours, offers support for any overnight issues, and assists with early morning wake-up routines. This position maintains a safe and structured environment for residents, supporting their emotional, behavioral, and physical needs in line with their treatment plans. (*This is not a live-in position*.)

Key Responsibilities

- Overnight Supervision:
 - Stay awake and alert throughout the shift to ensure resident and facility safety.
 - Conduct regular bed checks and wellness checks to monitor health and safety.
- Safety & Security:
 - Perform nightly lock-up and safety checks of the property, securing doors, windows, and equipment.
 - Follow emergency protocols, including fire drills, evacuations, or medical emergencies.



• Resident Support:

- Assist residents experiencing difficulties sleeping or needing overnight help.
- Provide nurturing and reassurance to upset or anxious residents.
- Implement behavior management techniques as per individual treatment plans.
- Communication & Documentation:
 - Maintain accurate shift documentation, including nightly checklists, medication logs, and incident reports.
 - Record and communicate significant changes in resident behavior, health, or well-being.
 - Conduct formal shift changes with morning staff and report issues to the Program Supervisor.
 - Complete all documentation before the end of the shift.
- Housekeeping & Other Duties:
 - Perform light housekeeping duties to maintain clean living spaces.
 - Assist with additional tasks assigned by the Operations Director or Program Supervisor.
- Support Services:
 - Contact on-call staff or external support services as needed.
 - Collaborate with day staff to prepare residents for the day, including meal prep and wake-up routines.

Qualifications & Requirements

- Education & Experience:
 - Seeking at least 7-10 years of work experience OR college degree.
- Licensing & Certifications:
 - Valid NC driver's license and reliable transportation.
 - Ability to pass required background checks, screenings, and mandatory training.
- Skills & Abilities:
 - Strong communication skills and record-keeping abilities.
 - Ability to remain awake and alert during night shifts, ensuring resident safety.
 - Competence in managing challenging behaviors and handling emergencies.
