Greetings from the Blueflash Sailing Team!

Here's the latest updates for July 25'


Wow! What an amazing first 4 months! Here's some key milestones to date:

- Over 100 sailors have participated since launching the first boats in April!
- We've run four clinics with 50 participants!
- Racing on Thursday's has been a huge success with up to 6 boats and 24 sailors on several nights!
- The huge task of launching and bring all 8 boats up to speed is (nearly) done!

What's next?

- All 8 boats are being booked for the six week block July 20 August 28. This is for Thursday Twilight Racing, Sailing on Sundays, and open practice anytime the skipper's make the call!
- Crew subscriptions are available for only \$50 for the whole six weeks! Under 30's are only \$25!
- Look out for a September Clinic Weekend with both an intermediate and advanced track! Meanwhile, private coaching
 options are available.
- Winter is coming! Well, eventually...but plans are in motion to continue the Sailing on Sunday's and if that's a bit wet and cold for you, look out for the opportunity to charter and race in sunny San Diego starting in November. Trust me, it's worth the trip!

Clinics

Clinics have been a huge success! We've run 4 monthly clinics to date with 6-18 participants. The format has evolved to include a 2 hour classroom session Friday evening followed by a 4 hour On the Water session Saturday. With a coach on each boat guiding a crew of 3, the instruction has been very personalized and we are seeing sailors make big advances in their knowledge and skills!

Look out for a September Clinic featuring both an intermediate and an advanced track for qualified sailors (and skippers) focusing on the nuances of sail trim, rig tune, and racing tactics for the Melges 20!

We have a few more tricks up our sleeves to share!

We are always looking to grow this part of the program, so advanced sailors should reach out, get onboard, and see why we believe fast is fun!



Crew Corner

Can anyone sail a high performance Melges 20 as a crew? Interestingly the answer is definitely YES! But it does depend on the wind conditions. We've learned that the boats have three different "personalities"

- 1. 0-10 Knots. Great conditions for anyone to learn!
- 2. 10-15 Knots. Things get lively! Requires two skilled sailors on the crew.
- 3. 15-20 Knots. Advanced only. Physically demanding.
- 4. Over 20 Knots. Better to stay on the dock than break something or someone!

That said, we are really pleased to see that the age breakdown of the sailors in the program is very equally spread out from age 10-72! The skipper group is almost identical. It looks like Blueflash Sailing Foundation is for the young at heart, not just the young!
