

Lake Erie walleye fishermen welcome near-record hatch in Western Basin; This year's survey found 112 walleye per roughly 2-1/2 acres of lake bottom, which was the second-highest to 2003's record numbers, and far above the 20-year average. The yellow perch hatch of 511 perch per roughly 2-1/2 acres of lake bottom was well above the 20-year average of 316 perch in that expanse.
