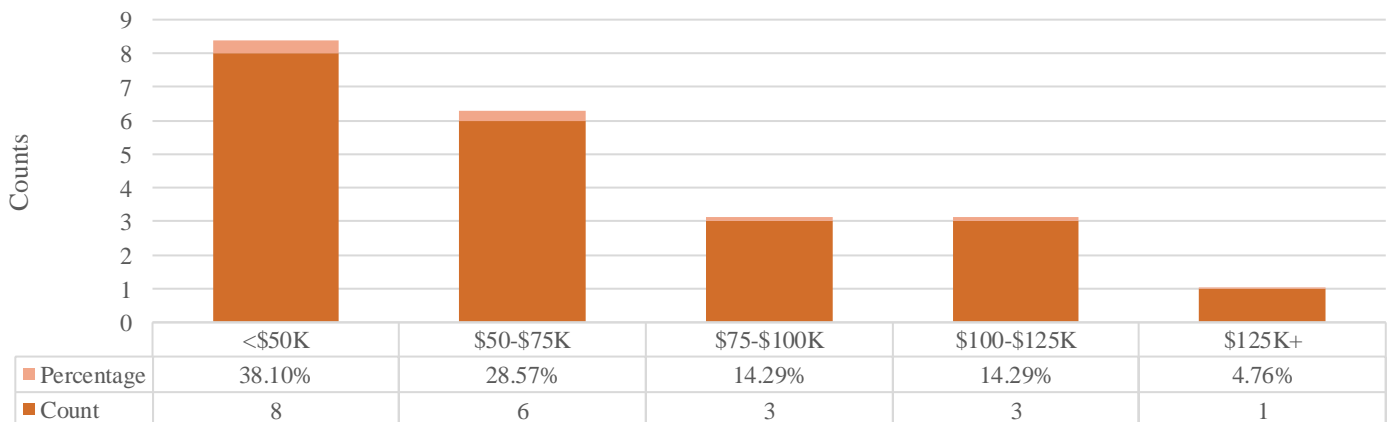

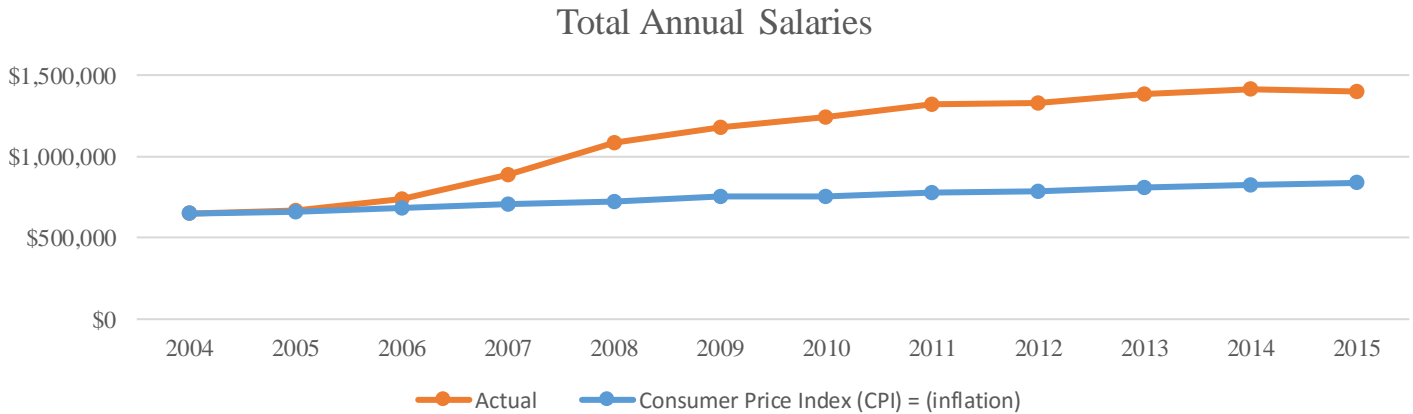

Top Pensions

"CONTRIBUTION:" the total dollars invested by individual employees when actively working- STATE TAXPAYERS fund the rest of payout. At death, LIFETIME half payments continue to legal partners.
