Interior dimensions continue to fluctuate during periods of isolation.

Hallway length increased by approximately 4.3 feet at 02:11 AM.

Subject crossed the area without acknowledgment.

Threshold sensitivity is declining.

Object no longer requires direct contact to influence the surrounding environment.

Notable event:

At 03:26 AM, the subject responded verbally to a stimulus originating from an empty laundry room.

Transcript fragment:

“Quinn?”

No juvenile presence confirmed at the time of response.

Audio source unidentified.

Subject approached the doorway.

Recording ends before entry.

Subject remains unaware he has already been observed from inside the structure.
