Flowers (and pollen) are blooming, baseball season has started, and sunset is happening after dinner again!

At our April 15th board meeting, we approved a budget for the fiscal year beginning May 1 - there is a write-up on Facebook explaining some of the changes that we made in the budget. We also discussed and approved a path forward for our ongoing contract negotiation with CA, and we went over an orientation that covers how OBCA operates. We also welcomed Surya Wright, who will join the Board at our next meeting on May 6th. I'm excited to work with Surya!

Bob Golibersuch decided not to seek reelection this year, after six years of service on the OBCA Board. Bob has been a thoughtful and detail-oriented volunteer over the years, and we will miss relying on his perspective and experience. If you see Bob around the neighborhood, please thank him for his service to the community.

At the time of writing, we're still finalizing contract details with CA. OBCA receives less grant funding per-capita than most other villages according to a formula developed in 2018. CA has previously told us that they would review how funding is allocated during this contract negotiation, jointly with the villages. For a variety of reasons this review did not happen, and the current draft contract extends the current funding formula until 2030 (unless all ten villages and CA agree to amend the contract to change it). We're asking CA to change the contract language to commit to re-evaluating the formula later this year, to take effect in May 2026.

There is an April 30th deadline for us to reach a new agreement, or to extend our current agreement. So this issue may be resolved by the time this newsletter hits your mailbox. Keep an eye on our Facebook page for more timely updates.

Our Annual Meeting will be on May 6th, followed by the first Board of Directors meeting of the new fiscal year. The primary agenda items will be organizational, re-appointing officers and committee members for the new year. # Your place to find friendly reminders regarding property maintenance

New from Howard County concerning EV chargers... Anyone who wants to install an EV charger is required to obtain a permit from the Howard County Dept of Inspections, Licenses and Permits. Not having a permit is a violation of the Howard County Building and Electrical Code. If you live in a single-family home all you need from the county is the permit. If you live in a townhouse, condo or duplex where you do not have your own driveway, you need a permit but there are also 7 steps that need to be followed before you can receive a permit from the County. Those steps are outlined on the following county website: https://bit.ly/3YINKrL.

An exterior alteration application is still required to be submitted and approved before any work is to begin. The application will not be considered unless the permit is attached. The Village of Owen Brown's Covenants cannot supersede Howard County Law.

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#### Highlights from CA Board of Directors Meeting

From the desk of Michael Golibersuch, OBCA Columbia Council Representative

Since my last report, the Columbia Association (CA) Board of Directors has held two meetings on March 27th and April 10th. By the time this article is published, there will have been an additional board meeting that took place on April 24th. Highlights of those meetings include:

- CA developed a new GIS tool to help residents explore Columbia. It conveniently maps CA facilities, events, and other information (such as pool status) onto an interactive map. Some features are still being refined but it can be found on CA's website:https://columbiaassociation.org/open-space/development/mapping-gis-resources/
- The Board reviewed CA's quarterly financials. CA completed
  the third quarter \$6M above budget mainly due to savings on
  IT projects and delays in capital projects. Looking forward,
  cuts to the federal workforce, federally funded research and
  associated contractors could have a large impact on the local
  economy and CA.
- The Board increased the amount of money CA is investing in its Emergency Cash Reserve to a total of \$5M. The reserve was established in the wake of the COVID pandemic to help shelter CA from future economic shocks. Increasing the

- amount invested in it this year will bring the reserve closer to its target size sooner and provide extra reserves that could be used if the local economy has a downturn.
- CA Open Space provided a presentation on new signage that will be used in open space. The samples look very nice and the pilot for the new program will be around Lake Elkhorn starting this year. CA Open Space will be providing a follow up presentation at an Owen Brown Board meeting later this year if you are interested in getting a sneak peak.
- CA staff also provided an update on its invasive species management program. Invasive species outcompete native species and cause harm to the local environment. CA's open space has multiple infestations and staff that work full time to mitigate or eliminate these infestations. Please be aware of invasive species in your yard and help eradicate them.
- Training is now underway to ensure outdoor pool staff are ready for the summer.


