Happy Fall! Leaves are turning, Thanksgiving plans are coming together, and we've seen a comet, a supermoon, and the northern lights all in the same week.

First, a bittersweet announcement. Craig Barton, Owen Brown's Village Manager, will be retiring in January. Craig has led our community association for twelve years. Under his leadership, OBCA has built a robust event series including the community carnival, 50th anniversary celebration, plant giveaways, and craft series, improved covenant enforcement and drastically reduced resident complaints, and updated our facilities.
