

"D" DAY

19 February 1945

- 0000 Security watch make hourly reports to the O.O.D.
0300 Reveille – Up all Hands.
0315 Mess Gear.
0330 Breakfast for crew and troops.
0400 Breakfast in Wardroom for ship's officers.
0545 General Quarters.
0600 Set Condition 1-A – Ungripe all boats.
0610 Syncreaize all watches.
0615 Arrive in Transport Area, hoist out boats when ordered. Clear all mess tables from Hatch #2, second deck, and open all second deck hatches. Rig yard and stay when required. Open all hatches.
0707 Sunrise, light ship.
0710 (Approximately) Commence debarking troops and unloading equipment. The 14th wave leave rendezvous circle to arrive at Line of Departure at H plus 50.
Special wave Rocket Det. H plus 60.
Special wave 37NH Plat. H plus 70.
Special wave Hq. CT 28 H plus 70
Special wave PDC, AR, AT, and Comm H plus 80 to LST 782
Hot Cargo Boat wave H plus 80
Service troops remaining on board after boats for first trip are loaded, will be on call.
0900 How Hour.
1030 Feed on stations.
After LCV(P) 8 and 15 return from initial trip, they will be retained at ship.
1530 Feed on stations.
1600 Have smoke boats manned and ready.
1630 Smoke boats on station if ship is to remain in Transport Area.
1810 Make preparation to darken ship.
1831 Sunset, darken ship.
1930 Feed on stations, if in Transport Area.
2000 Security watch make hourly reports to the O.O.D.

NOTE #1:

Trash, wooden crates, or empty drums must not be thrown over the side in the Transport Area. All nets if not in use will be rigged in, or pulled well clear of water.

NOTE #2:

All Ship's keys issued to troops and troop officers will be returned to the First Lieutenant's Office prior to debarkation.
