CE Stars Code of Conduct Contract

Players and Parents/Guardians, please read the following contract for the upcoming CE Stars sports season. Youth sports programs play an important role in promoting the physical, social, and emotional development of all participants. It is therefore essential for coaches, parents, attendees, players and referees to encourage youth athletes to embrace the values of good sportsmanship. There is no better way to achieve this than by leading by example and demonstrating fairness, respect, and self-control (“sportsmanship”). Please read over this with your child and sign the last page of this contract and return it to Joe Mead, Vice-President, Operations – CE Stars.

As a player in the CE Stars Program, I agree to the following code of conduct:

1. To train and play to the best of my abilities.
2. To keep a positive mental attitude.
3. Arrive promptly and ready to go for all practices and games and communicate to coaches prior to a tardy or absence.
4. Use of profanity, both on and off the field will NOT be tolerated.
5. Respect my coaches and teammates, and only give positive encouragement.
6. Respect my opponents and teammates and not play in a way that would purposely hurt or injure another player.
7. Treat all referees with proper respect and accept their decisions without argument.
8. Accept my role on the team and respect coaches decisions without question.
9. Exhibit humility when winning and grace when losing.
10. To remember that I represent myself, my family, CE Stars and my team with my actions, play and comments.

As it is the mission of CE Stars, through sports, to develop our youth to become responsible young people, we will require our players to be academically accountable and liable for any actions that reflect negatively on themselves, their parents, CE Stars, their team and our community.

As a parent of a player or volunteer in the CE Stars Program, I agree to the following code of conduct:

1. Help my player to meet all team and CE Stars expectations and commitments. Failure to do so can result in removal from team and loss of fees.
2. Parents will accept the team placement of your player and respect coaches decisions.

3. Be encouraging, supportive and affirmative in regard to ALL players on the field.
4. Be respectful of ALL referees, players, coaches, and spectators. Parents/volunteers who do NOT display appropriate behavior on the sidelines WILL be asked and expected to leave the area.
5. Parents will accept the coach's decisions during games and practices. If concerns arise and you feel you need to speak to a coach please arrange a time that is NOT right before, during, or right after a practice or game.
6. Make sure that any family or friends that are attending games with you, adhere to the CE Stars policies in regard to acceptable sideline behavior.
7. Pay or arrange payment options for all player, CE Stars or team fees by their due dates.

*****Zero Tolerance Policy for Referee/Game Official Abuse*****

The purpose of such a policy is:

1. To establish an environment that is conducive to good sportsmanship. The game will benefit if respect is shown by and to everyone involved, including referees, coaches, players, parents, and fans.
2. To establish an environment that is conducive to recruitment and retention of referees.

It is expected that everyone involved with CE Stars activities will behave in a responsible manner. Please be aware of the following:

1. Youth sports are a learning experience and mistakes will be made by all involved.
2. Respect should be shown to all players, coaches, supporters, and officials.
3. Supporting a team does not give you the right to be rude or abusive.
4. Please respect the integrity and judgment of the officials and use of abusive, inappropriate actions or language will NOT be tolerated.
5. Please behave in a manner that exhibits class that would never cause CE Stars or its member clubs embarrassment.
6. As a member of CE Stars, players, parents & volunteers must be committed to our organization for the full season. The player/coach will not be permitted to participate in the sport he/she is enrolled in with CE Stars for any other organization for the length of the currently enrolled season.
7. Failure to follow this policy as outlined above and in the Player and Parent Code of Conduct will result in referral to the BOD for disciplinary action which can ultimately lead to the removal of the player/coach from the team and result in loss of fees.

CE Stars Code of Conduct Contract

We (volunteers and/or parents and/or players) have read and hereby agree to abide by the CE Stars code of conduct.

We also understand that failure to do so is subject to disciplinary action, including but not limited to the following in any order or combination, at the discretion of the CE Stars Board:

- Oral or written warning
- Suspension or immediate ejection from any CE Stars event
- Suspension from multiple CE Stars events
- Season suspension
- Permanent termination from some or all CE Stars events
- Notification of and request for support by local law enforcement

Note: No reimbursement of fees will be made due to the dismissal of a player from a game or the team for not adhering to this contract as outlined.
