Our new vans are lower to the ground, making them more accessible to many of the adults residing in our supported living homes. "The height of the older vehicles made it difficult for people to get in and out," shares Laurine Didier, a Supported Living Program Supervisor at Aptus. "One lady did not want to go out because the step was too high and there was not enough space for her to maneuver. Getting out was so difficult, she had to sit and struggle her way out with staff support."

Thankfully, when getting in and out is easier, the ride more comfortable, and the vehicles reliable, it makes everything easier – whether it's daily errands, appointments, or planning and enjoying an outing that doesn't get postponed or cancelled because of a need for a repair.

The new vehicles are also giving staff the confidence to plan outings more often and further afield according to Rosemary Ezeh, another Supported Living Program Supervisor at Aptus. "We can now go on long-distance outings, especially in the summer to fun places, and this will improve the quality of life for individuals while reducing anxiety."
