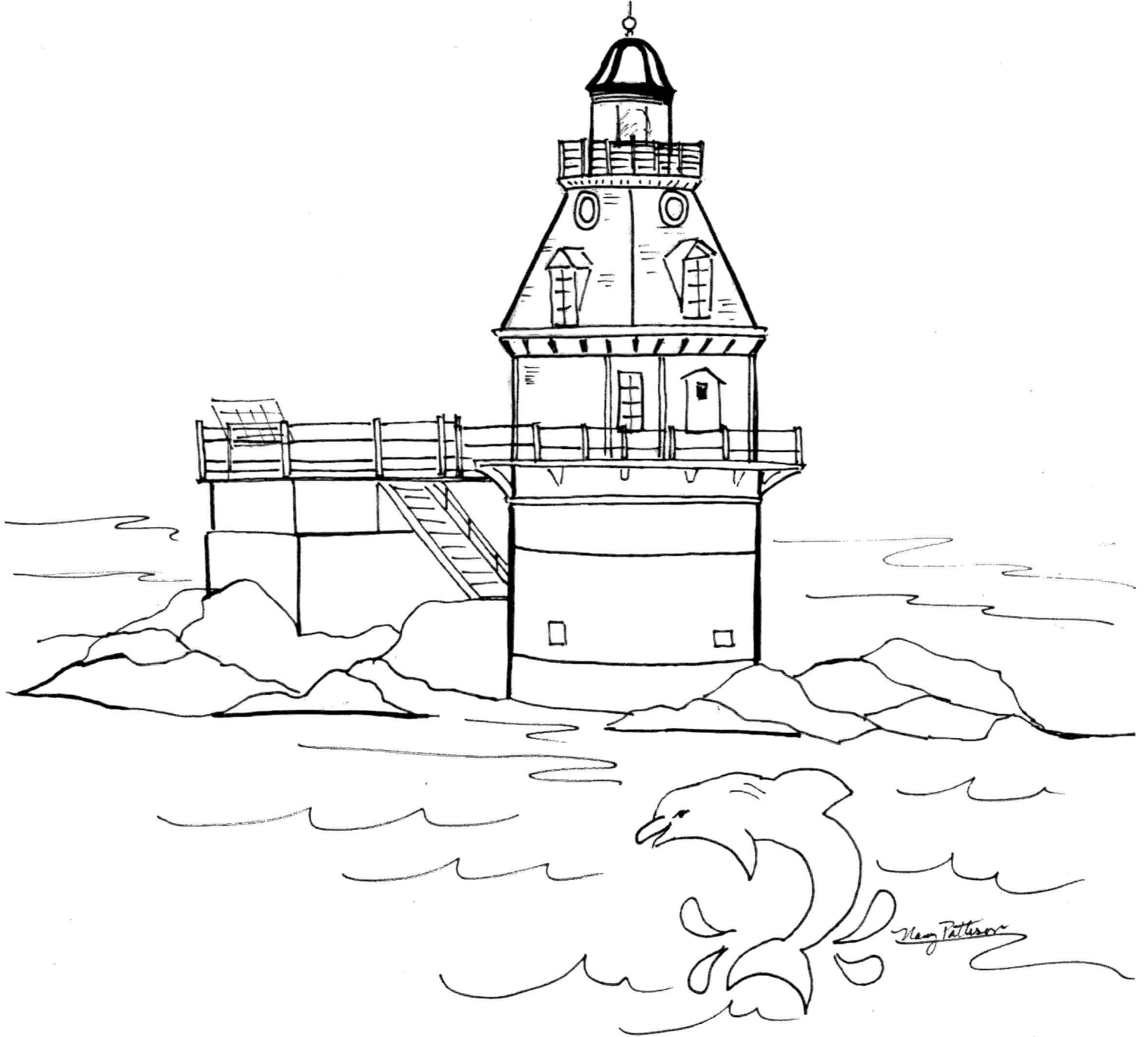


DELAWARE BAY LIGHTS



DID YOU KNOW?

1. There are five lighthouses in a line far out in the Bay. Ships follow them for about 35 miles up to the mouth of the Delaware River.
2. The Lighthouse in this picture is called "Ship John Shoal." It is named after a ship that got struck in the shallow sand there on Christmas Eve, 1797.
