2018 Riesling 11.5% ABV (alcohol by volume) A semi-sweet riesling (4% residual alcohol) from Grand Valley AVA grapes.	\$17	\$5
2016 Pinot Grigio 13.5% ABV Organic grapes from West Elks AVA. Fermented and aged in stainless steel in the Italian style, versus the French style for the identical grape, pinot gris.	\$17	\$5
2018 Chardonnay 14.5% ABV Produced from grapes grown in the Grand Valley AVA. Fermented and aged in stainless steel with no exposure to oak. The crisp flavors of the chardonnay grape shine through.	\$20	\$6
 <u>Red Wines</u>		
2016 St. Vincent 13.1% ABV These North American hybrid red grapes were grown in the Grand Valley AVA. Yields a pleasant Chianti-like sangiovese wine. Crisp with mild acidity.	\$18	\$6
2018 Syrah 14.2% ABV A well-balanced and full-bodied red. The hot and dry summer climate of the Grand Valley emulates France's Rhone Valley, producing ripe and flavorful grapes.	\$20	\$6
2018 Merlot 14.6% ABV The classic Bordeaux grape produced in the Grand Valley AVA.	\$20	\$6
2018 Primitivo 15.7% ABV A close cousin, if not twin, of zinfandel, primitivo thrives in the Mediterranean heat of Puglia, the heel of Italy's boot, and the Grand Valley AVA. An early ripener ("primi"), the grape delivers that heat in a fruit forward balanced wine. A unique offering among West Elks wineries.	\$22	\$7
2018 Petite Pearl 15.4% ABV Limited Production - 10 cases Our first estate grown and produced wine. Petite pearl is a new cold hardy American hybrid bred to reduce acidity to more closely match Old World vinifera. Produces an almost inky and balanced wine. Only commercial Petite Pearl in Colorado.	\$28	\$8
