INSTRUCTIONS

- (1) Holding the Tapemate® in one hand and the tape measure in the other hand at a 45° angle.
- (2) Depress the middle of the Tapemate® slightly inward and under the retainer of the tape measure from the inside. Adjusting the retainer slightly will cause it to snap into place for a snug fit.
- (3) Simply extend the Tapemate® over the piece of work, keeping the tension of the tape measure constant and extending the tape measure to the desired length for your measurement.
- (4) To detach, simply bend the Tapemate® downward and away from the end of the tape measure.
- (5) Your Tapemate® will fit most of the tape measures on the market today, especially the lower priced ones.
- (6) Tapemate does not warrant the middle and fingers of the Tapemate® from breaking. Like any other tool, used properly, it will last a long time.

Thank you for purchasing the Tapemate®. The Tapemate® can be of significant assistance when attached to a tape measure. You will find many other uses for the Tapemate® as well as an aid in holding the end of the tape measure on a piece of wood as shoe molding, conduit, pipe, steel rod, sheet metal, vinyl siding, etc., while a measurement is being taken. Tapemate® when attached properly, adds only about 1/16 of an inch to the overall length when using the inside and about 1 inch when using the outside. When using the side "Teeth" on the Tapemate®, it will add 7/8 of an inch to your overall measurements.
