MEDIA Q & A

Who is the inspiration for these books?

My daughters. I have one who didn't want to join the dance squad club at her school and came up with a fantastical reason that she was a dancer from another planet with out of this world skills. I have another daughter who loves to dance. It wasn't hard to draw experience from them both.

What is this book's key message to children?

Fevah's story teaches children transitional confidence. Transitional confidence is an empowering bridging framework, which I discovered through this project. Young readers and parents of young readers will find it easy to partner with Fevah as she navigates the bumps in the road between what she wants and where she wants to go, as she learns to not give up and finds her inner superhero to push through. The message is simple - listen to advice, accept support, dig deep, reposition, and keep going.

Why is the message so important today?

Children need to see, or read about, a version of themselves. They need to know that how they look, or what they are thinking, is shared by someone else and that that person is going through the same emotional hoops as they are. It shouldn't matter whether it is on planet Earth or on planet Echo Rise. Fevah, the main character, is positioned to be that version of themselves that is exuberant and whimsical. Other times, anxious and doubtful. She shares secrets about herself that she couldn't admit out loud. Covid stagnated social growth for children and adults alike and many of us closed ourselves off. Many of us have bounced back, but many of us are still two-years behind. Wherever you are in age or social growth, don't panic and work on the things that work for you. But keep working on it and the hard things get easier. But you have to let people in, let them help you, and trust in change. I know this with experience!

How do these lessons carry through to adults?

I had dreams I did not push through and gave up on simply because they got hard or I looked around and thought someone else was doing it better, so why bother.

Goodness, I still do that today, which is all the more reason for me to get this message out that confidence is within and around us. It isn't something that we can buy or take. It's what keeps us gravitational still when meteorites rock our core.

What is one of most important things you've learned through this project?

If you have a dream, hold on to it, manifest its reality. Another lesson that goes beyond self-will is listening to advice. The advice given may require me to slow down or pivot. This may be the best thing to do, but I have to put my ego aside in order to receive it.
