

Healing Scriptures



How to use these scriptures:

1. Put them up around your house or hospital room. Read them several times a day. Meditate on them. Memorize them. They will strengthen your faith and help you maintain a victorious mindset.

2. Speak them over yourself. Personalize them and make them your own. They belong to you. Believe that you have the title deed to them, accept them as fact, and keep believing them no matter what.

3. Incorporate them into your prayers. God is not bound by anything else but His word, and He likes to hear His word quoted back to Him. For example, you can say in your prayers, "God, you said Jesus bore all my sicknesses and infirmities upon Himself at the Cross and that by His stripes I was healed. Thank You that Jesus already paid the price for my healing. I receive complete healing, wholeness, and restoration in every part of my body right now, in Jesus' name."

Exodus 15:26 - "For I am the Lord who heals you."

Exodus 23:25 - "I will take sickness away from the midst of you."

2 Kings 20:5 - "I have heard your prayer, I have seen your tears; surely I will heal you."

Jer. 30:17 - "For I will restore health to you and heal you of your wounds, says the Lord."





Psalm 103:2,3 - "Bless the Lord, O my soul, and forget not all His benefits: Who forgives all your iniquities, Who heals all your diseases."

Matt 8:17 - "He Himself [Jesus] took our infirmities and bore our sicknesses."

1 Peter 2:24 (NIV) - "...by His wounds you have been healed."

Psalm 30:2 - "O Lord my God, I cried out to You, and You healed me."

Isaiah 38:16 (NLT) - "You restore my health and allow me to live."

Jer. 17:14 - "Heal me, oh Lord, and I will be healed."

Prov. 4:20-22 - God's word is health to my whole body.

Psalm 91:16 (CEV) - "You will live a long life and see my saving power."

Psalm 118:17 - "I shall not die, but live, and declare the works of the Lord."

Job 5:9 - "[God] performs wonders that cannot be fathomed, miracles that cannot be counted."

Jer. 32:27 - "Behold, I am the Lord, the God of all flesh. Is there anything too hard for me?"

Jer. 32:17 - "Lord God, it is You who made the heavens and the earth by Your great power and by Your outstretched arm! Nothing is too hard for You."

Mark 10:27 - "All things are possible with God."

Luke 18:27 - "What is impossible with men is possible with God."

Mark 9:23 - "If you can believe, all things are possible to him who believes."

Matt. 17:20 - "If you have faith like a grain of mustard seed, nothing will be impossible for you."

Isaiah 54:17 - "No weapon formed against you shall prosper."

Psalm 34:17 - "The righteous cry out and the Lord hears and delivers them out of all their troubles."

Ps. 46:1 - "God is our refuge and strength, a very present help in trouble."



Gen. 20:17 - "So Abraham prayed to God; and God healed Abimelech, his wife, and his female servants."

Ps 107:19-21 - Then they cried out to the Lord in their trouble, and He saved them out of their distresses. He sent His word and healed them, and delivered them from their destructions. Oh, that men would give thanks to the Lord for His goodness and for His wonderful works to the children of men!
