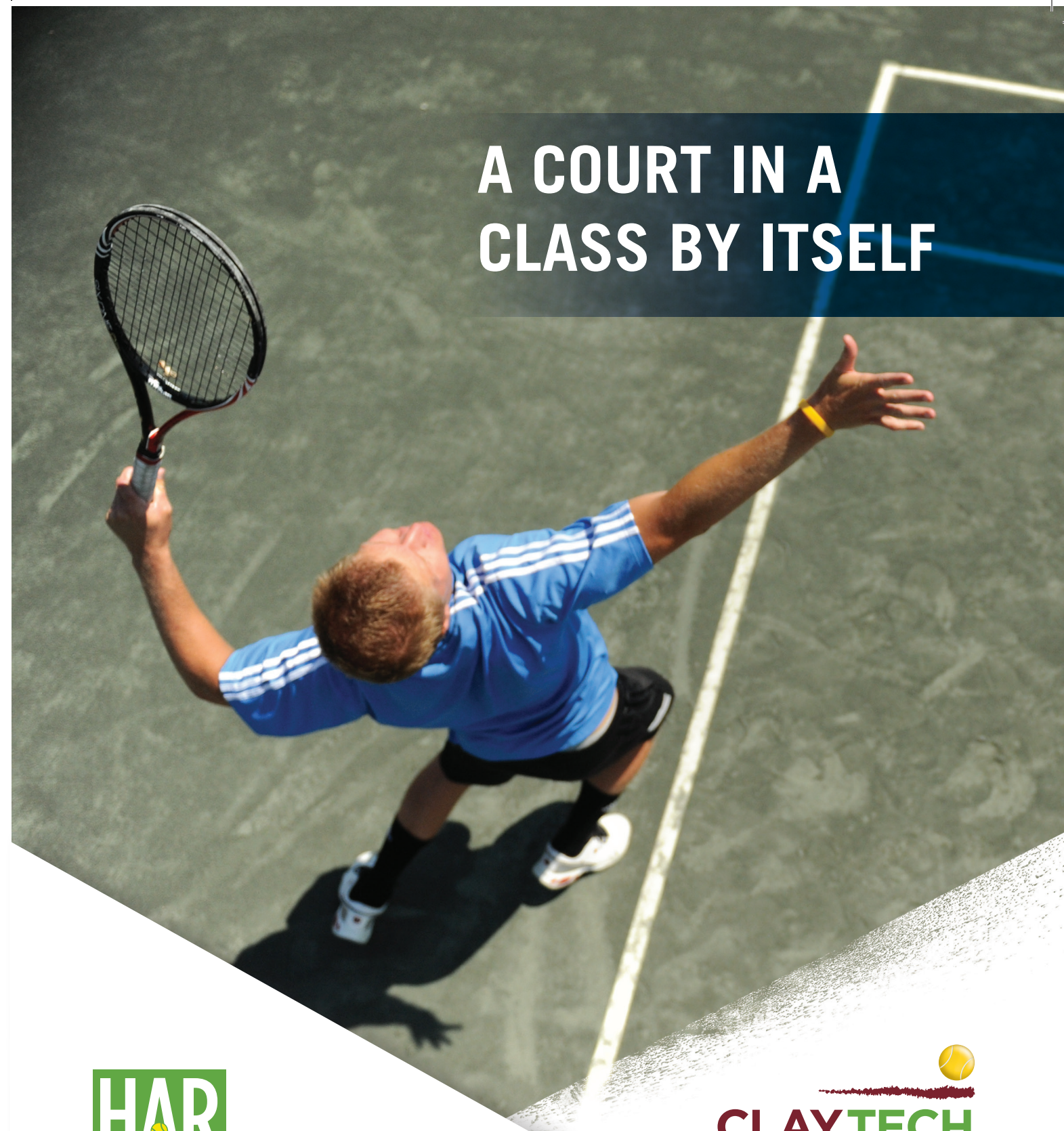

Serious tennis players love clay courts because they can play on them every day — from childhood through retirement — with greater skill and fewer injuries.

A clay court surface acts as a cushion that allows players to slide into their shots, preventing the jolting stops that are common on hard courts.

Feet slide and pivot freely across a clay surface, which greatly reduces the chance of injuries.

Playing on a clay court also provides a slower ball bounce than other court surfaces. This results in longer rallies, a greater variety of shots, and a more controlled game.

Clay courts help players develop and refine the core skills needed to succeed in tennis — footwork and balance skills, physical and mental endurance, a wide range of shots, and the ability to construct shot sequences and turn them into points.

► Minimal Maintenance and Expense

ClayTech® courts are easy to maintain and require little experience, equipment, or knowledge. The unique surface eliminates the need to repaint the court of every three to five years. ClayTech is a ready-to-play court that requires nothing more than a simple sweep and a spritz of water, even after a season of inactivity.

ClayTech courts have a proven track record and have been installed in Europe for more than 15 years and in the United States for more than 10 years.

► More Durable Than Hard Courts

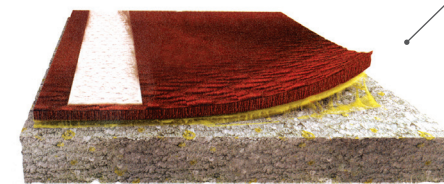
ClayTech courts are more durable than hard courts. The polypropylene membrane mat covers holes, cracks, and other deficiencies in an existing substrate, contributing to an exceptionally long court life. Lines are painted in place during installation and last for several years without attention.

► Easy Installation

ClayTech can be easily installed over an existing hard court surface with minimal preparation. The surface material is fully glued down and then filled with HAR-TRU® to give it the look and feel of clay, without the associated care. The lines are a special filler material that lasts for years. Installation can be completed in as little as two days.

► All-Weather Playability

ClayTech is the first truly all-weather tennis court. Hard courts are characterized as all weather, but you can't safely use them during rain or snow. With ClayTech, your footing remains safe and substantially unchanged — whether it's wet, dry, hot, or freezing cold. Designed specifically to withstand extensive outdoor use, ClayTech courts are playable immediately after a rainfall and highly resistant to UV rays. Freeze-thaw problems are nonexistent with ClayTech. And during the hottest days of summer, ClayTech remains cooler than hard courts.



The ClayTech subsurface is a polypropylene membrane installed over a concrete or asphalt base. HAR-TRU® clay is then laid on top to create a classic playing surface. Much like a hard court, ClayTech features permanent lines that only occasionally need to be touched up with new paint.
