1. Information We Collect

Personal Data

2. How We Use Your Information

Having accurate information about you permits us to provide you with a smooth, efficient, and customized experience. Specifically, we may use information collected about you via the Site to:

- **Provide Legal Services:** Respond to inquiries, evaluate potential conflicts of interest, and manage prospective or ongoing client relationships.

- **Business Transfers:** If we reorganize or sell all or a portion of our assets, undergo a merger, or are acquired by another entity, your information may be transferred to the successor entity.

SMS/10DLC Exclusion: Notwithstanding any other provision in this Privacy Policy, **no mobile information or text messaging originator opt-in data and consent will be shared with, sold, or rented to third parties or affiliates for marketing or promotional purposes.** All the above categories exclude text messaging originator opt-in data and consent; this information will not be shared with any third parties.

4. Text Messaging (SMS) and 10DLC Compliance

If you provide your mobile telephone number to McGregor Dunn Law LLC, you agree that we may send you text messages (SMS/MMS) related to your inquiries, legal matters, updates, or other services you have requested.

- **Opt-In/Consent:** By providing your phone number and checking the consent box on our website forms, you explicitly consent to receive text messages from us. Consent to receive automated text messages is not a condition of purchasing any goods or services.
- **Opt-Out:** You can cancel the SMS service at any time. Just text "**STOP**" to the number from which you received the message. After you send the SMS message "STOP" to us, we will send you an SMS message to confirm that you have been unsubscribed. After this, you will no longer receive SMS messages from us. If you want to join again, just sign up as you did the first time.

- **Rates:** Message and data rates may apply for any messages sent to you from us and to us from you. Message frequency varies based on your interaction with us.
