

RECYCLING



PCSWA and the City of Hurricane are partnering to bring a recycling drop-off site to Hurricane, WV open to all Putnam County residents!

Items accepted will include:

- #1PET plastics
- Mixed paper
- Cardboard
- Aluminum cans

Plastics Done Right:

#1 PET Bottles!

- DO Recycle: Water bottles, soda bottles, clear plastic food containers (look for #1 inside the triangle).
- DON'T Include: Bottle caps (unless specified), plastic bags, dirty containers.
- Pro Tip: Rinse before recycling and remove labels if possible!

Recycle Right:

Cardboard & Paper!

- DO Recycle: Flattened cardboard boxes, newspapers, magazines, office paper, junk mail.
- DON'T Include: Pizza boxes (greasy), wax-coated cartons, wet or soiled paper.
- Tip: Keep paper and cardboard dry and separate from food waste!

Aluminum: Infinitely Recyclable!

- DO Recycle: Soda cans, beer cans, clean aluminum foil, pie tins.
- DON'T Include: Food-covered foil, aerosol cans, paint cans.
- Fun Fact: Recycling one aluminum can saves enough energy to power a TV for 3 hours!
