

RECYCLING

PCSWA and the City of Hurricane are partnering to bring a recycling drop-off site to Hurricane, WV open to all Putnam County residents!

Items accepted include:

-#1 & #2 plastics -Cardboard -Steel Cans -Mixed paper
-Aluminum cans -Soft Plastics

#1 & #2 Plastics

- Empty and rinse before recycling
- Remove caps and lids (recycle separately if accepted)
- Labels can stay on

Mixed Paper

- Includes newspapers, magazines, office paper, junk mail, and paper bags
- Remove food residue, tape, or plastic wrap
- No wax-coated or heavily soiled paper

Cardboard

- Break down and flatten all boxes
- Remove packing materials (plastic wrap, foam, peanuts, etc.)
- Keep clean and dry – no greasy pizza boxes or food residue

Soft Plastics (like grocery bags, bread bags, and shrink wrap):

- Clean, dry, and free of food residue
- Remove any labels or stickers when possible
- Bundle bags together into one bag before recycling

Steel / Tin Cans

- Empty and rinse thoroughly
- Labels can remain on
- Flatten if possible to save space

Aluminum: Infinitely Recyclable!

- DO Recycle: Soda cans, beer cans, clean aluminum foil, pie tins.
- DON'T Include: Food-covered foil, aerosol cans, paint cans.
- Fun Fact: Recycling one aluminum can saves enough energy to power a TV for 3 hours!
