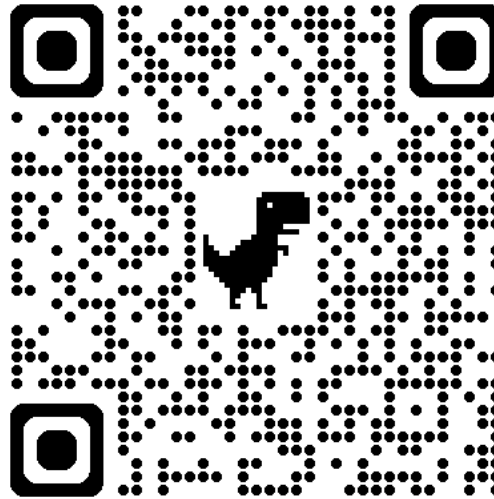

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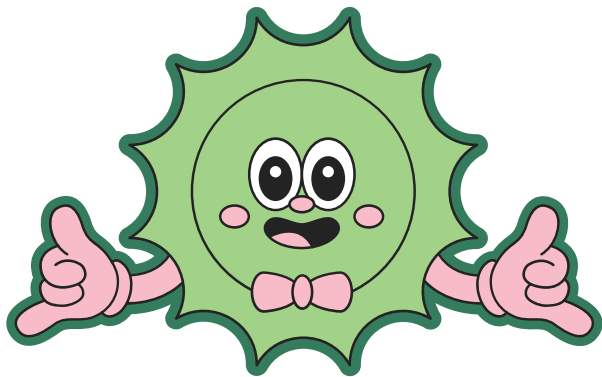

Mixed Paper

- Includes newspapers, magazines, office paper, junk mail, and paperback books.
- Remove food residue, tape, or plastic wrap
- No wax-coated or heavily soiled paper
- Envelope windows are OK!

Aluminum cans

- DO Recycle: Soda cans, beer cans, clean aluminum foil, pie tins.
- DON'T Include: Food-covered foil, aerosol cans, paint cans.
- Fun Fact: Recycling one aluminum can saves enough energy to power a TV for 3 hours!



#1 & #2 Plastics

#1 Plastics

- Common items: water bottles, soda bottles, sports drink bottles, salad dressing containers.

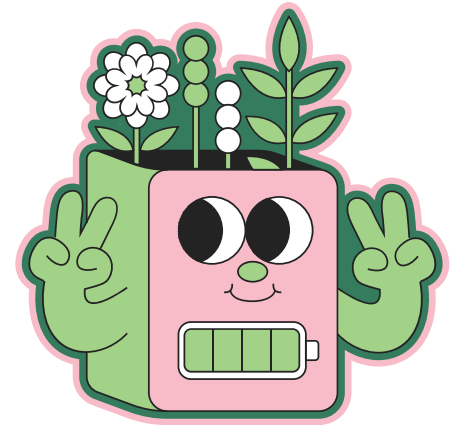
#2 Plastics

- Common items: milk jugs, laundry detergent bottles, shampoo bottles, juice containers.
- Preparation Tip: Always rinse containers to remove food or liquid residue before recycling.



Cardboard

- **BREAK DOWN AND FLATTEN ALL BOXES**
- Remove packing materials (plastic wrap, foam, peanuts, etc.)
- Keep clean and dry — no greasy pizza boxes or food residue



Steel / Tin Cans

- Empty and rinse thoroughly
- Labels can remain on
- Flatten if possible to save space

Soft Plastics (grocery bags, bread bags, and shrink wrap):

- Clean, dry, and free of food residue
- Remove any labels or stickers when possible
- Bundle bags together into one bag before recycling
