



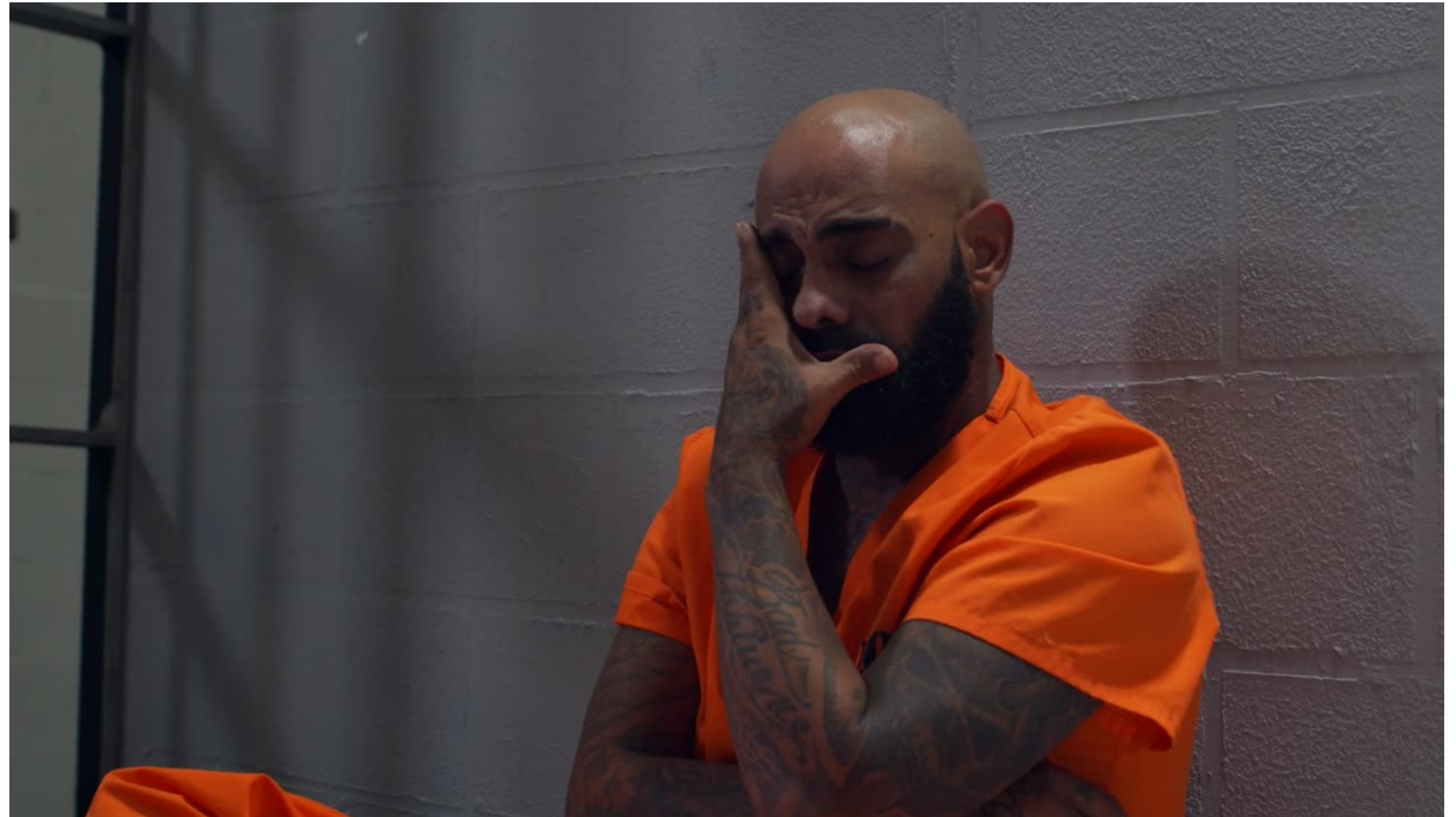

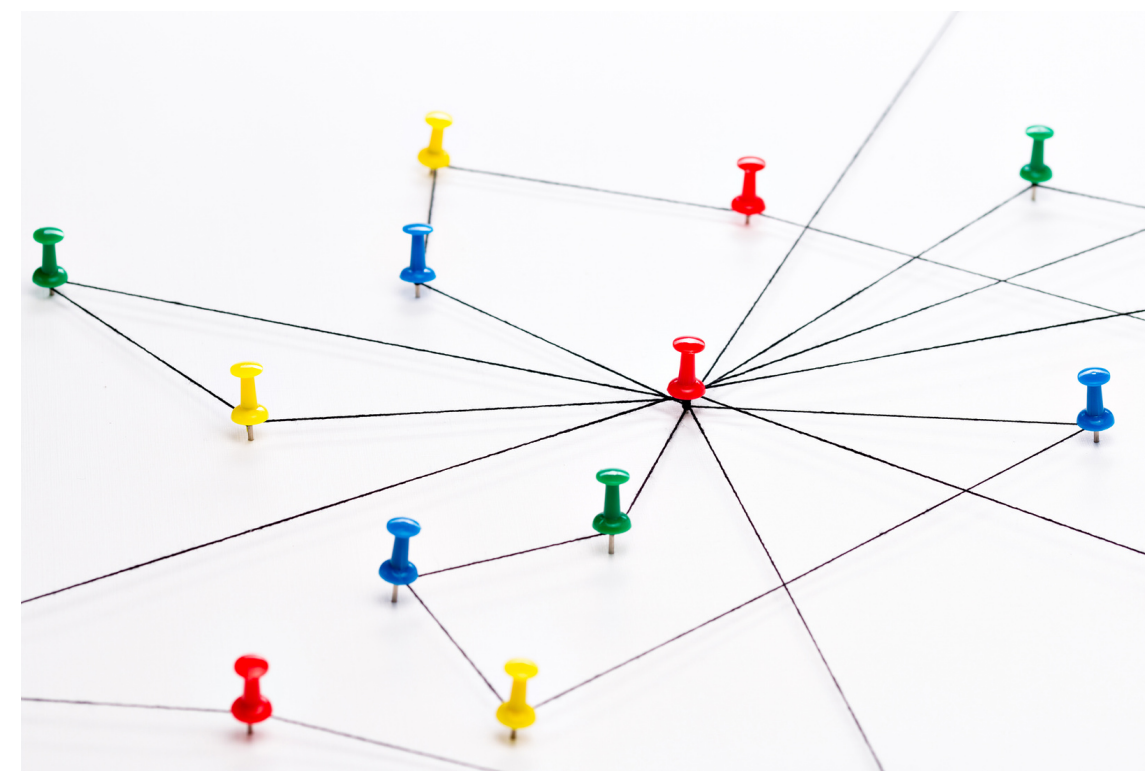


We champion the fundamental truth that there is not only life after prison, but the potential for growth, leadership, and positive change that enriches our entire community.

Our Let's Get Technical program is designed to help build essential technology skills in a supportive and hands-on environment.

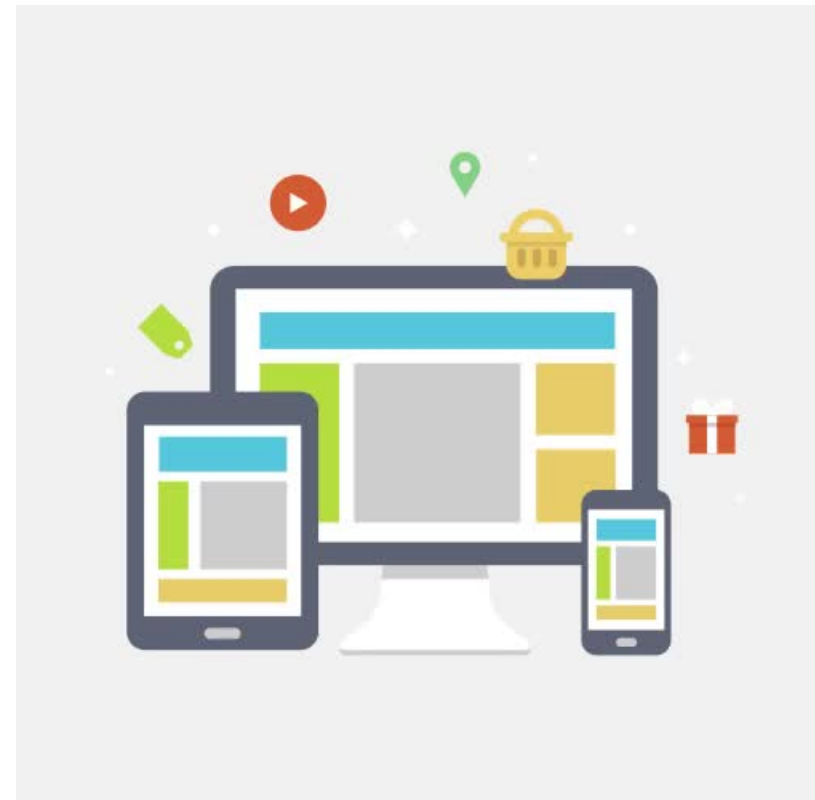
MY SUCCESSFUL BLUEPRINT

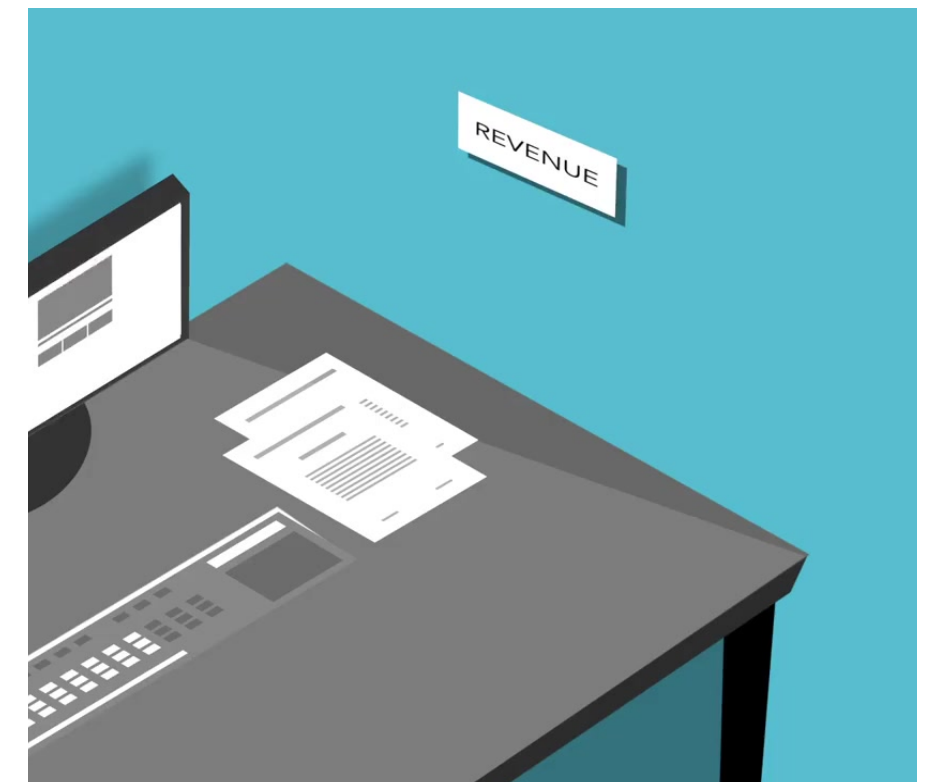

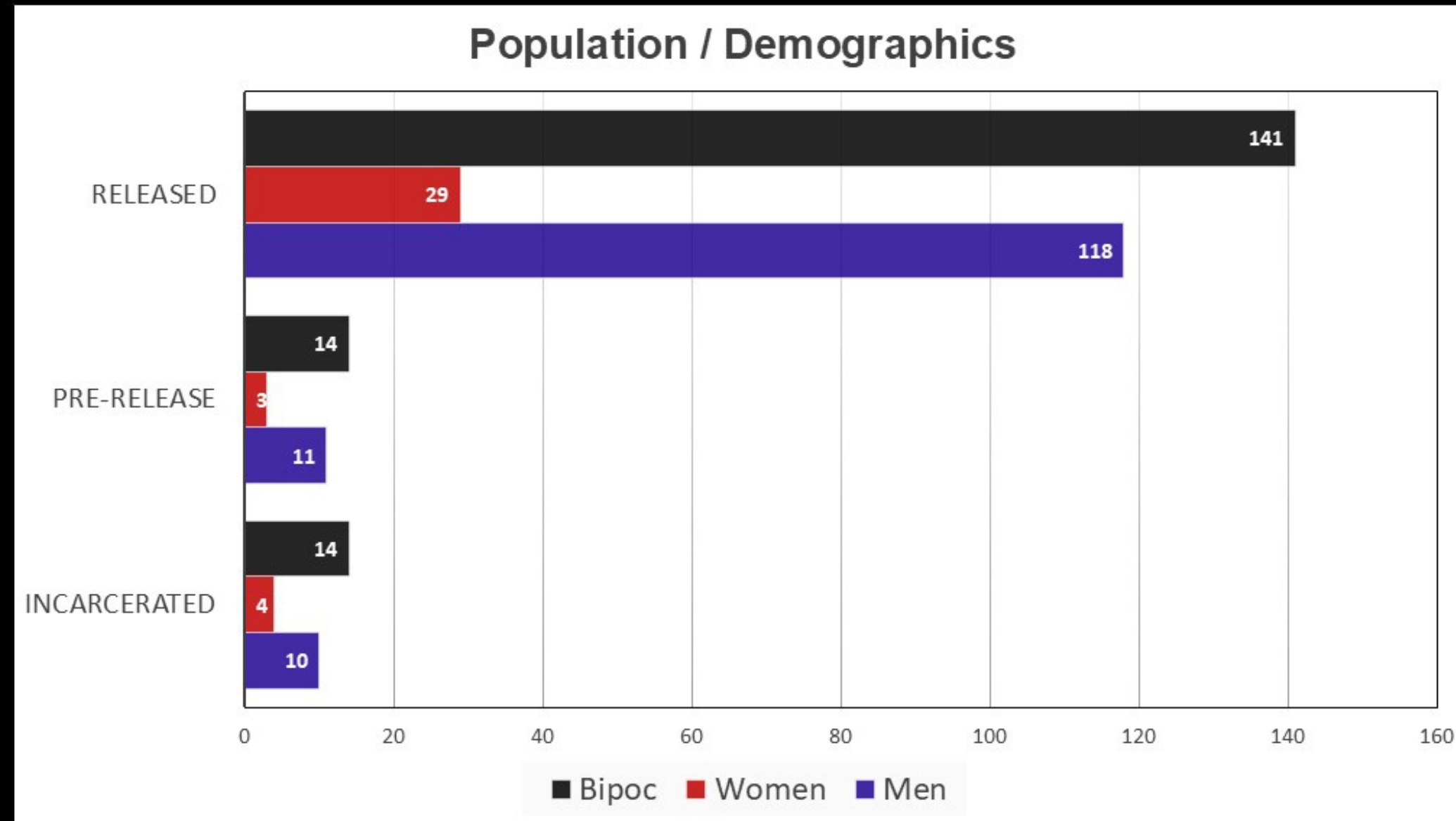

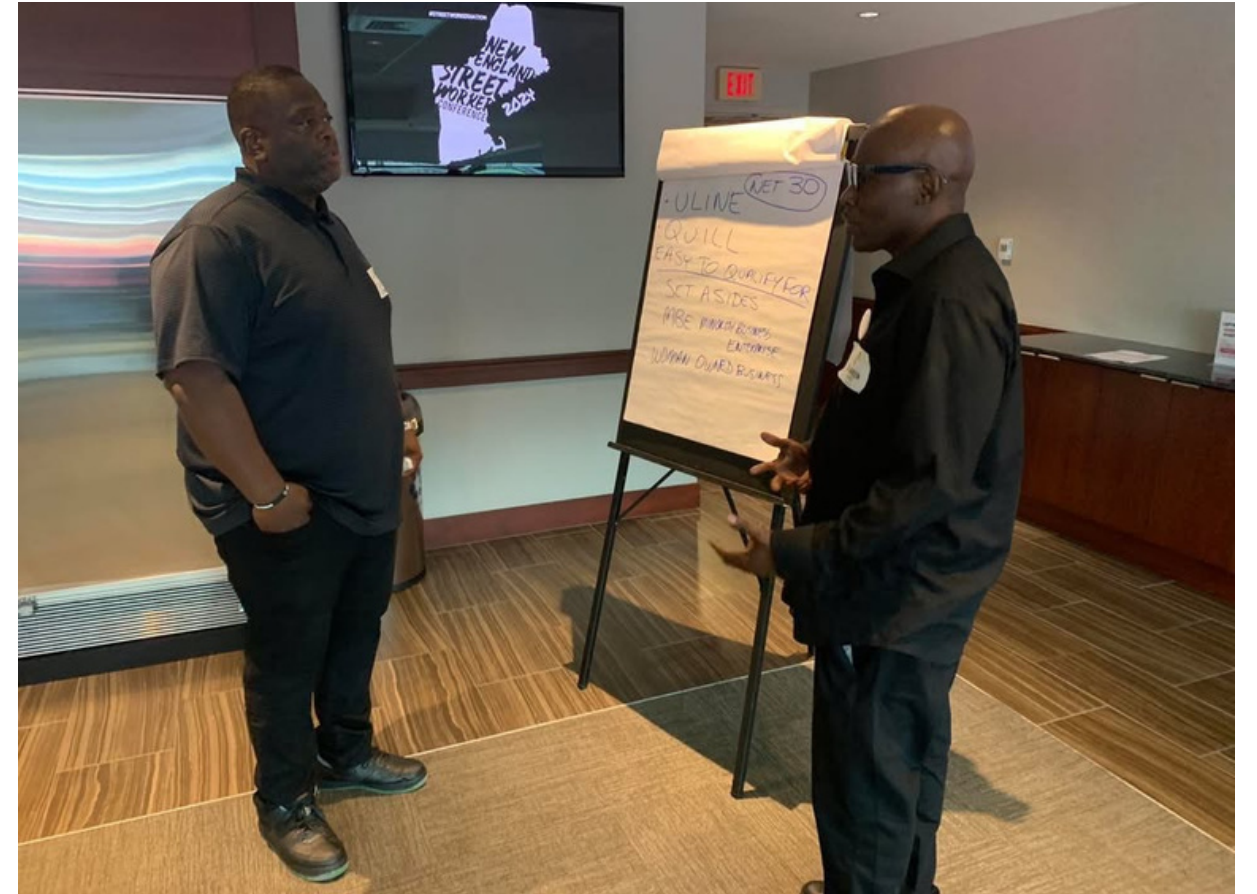
