
APRIL BOOK CLUB

The following are weekly Bible studies available to all. Invite a friend and enjoy fellowship and a more in-depth understanding of the weekly lessons from *The Story*.


Sunday Study Group - Sundays after 9:30 worship, using *The Story.* April 8, 15, 22 and 29 (no Sunday School on Easter).

Building on the powerful story and arguments he shared in *Seeking Allah, Finding Jesus*, Nabeel Qureshi and coauthor Kevin Harney take viewers deeper into apologetics and evangelism among Muslims with this complete study course. In eight videobased lessons, Qureshi and Harney explore Muslim culture, the most common Mus-

lim objections to Christianity, and the core doctrines upon which Islam stands or falls. Compassionate and clear, the *Seeking Allah Finding Jesus Study Guide* will be a useful training tool for any believer wanting to winsomely engage Muslims in spiritual conversations.

The Seeking Allah, Finding Jesus Study Guide develops in further detail the objections to Islam and case for Christianity that Qureshi introduced in his book Seeking Allah, Finding Jesus.

We will be using this great resource as for our Adult Sunday School class and a mid-week study (time TBA) in May and June.

Hymn Facts

"Christ the Lord is Risen Today", sung on Easter Sunday, was written by Charles Wesley (1707-1780), originally called "Hymn for Easter Day" and published in 1739. It first consisted of eleven stanzas. The Alleluias were added later to make the text fit the tune. The tune first appeared in the *Lyra Davidica* hymnal in 1708, with no composer credited.

And the angel said "He is not here. He has risen..." (Matthew 28:6) **Alleluia!**
