I know it seems that we have just cleaned up after the Christmas season. It is, however, getting close to the season of Lent. We will begin that part of the calendar dedicated to the 'internal look' on Ash Wednesday, March 6th. On that day there will be a worship service that includes the imposition of ashes at 7:00pm.



During Lent, Road to Emmaus Church will also be engaging in a study of Philippians using a book called *Because Of This I Rejoice*. This resource will offer each of us three ways of Lenten reflection. First, our Sunday sermons will track with the readings and second, there is a set of individual readings for your daily devotional time.
