### Supplies:

- Precision Fine tip tweezers (Recommended: Heidi Proffetty's Precision Tweezers available at www.heldiproffetty.com/shop and also available in class).
- Elmer's® washable glue stick
- Straight pins or Quilt Clips

### **Sewing Machine Supplies:**

Quilters should have a good working knowledge of how to set up their machine for free motion and how to do basic stippling or meandering quilting.

- **Sewing Machines** are recommended but not required for this workshop. Attendees are welcome to focus solely on the mosaic design aspects and building their poinsettia mosaic kit during class and then complete the free-motion guilting at home if they prefer.
- Power cord, foot controller and extension cord
- Free-Motion Quilting Foot & Needle Plate
- Standard Zig Zag Presser Foot & Standard Needle Plate
- Small sharp fine-tip or embroidery scissors (Recommended: Karen Kay Buckley brand red perfect curved scissors)
- 80 or 100 weight polyester thread used for bobbin thread. Color: Black or Dark Blue
- (Recommended Brands: Wonderfil DecoBob 80 Wt, Wonderfil InvisaFil 100 Wt, or Superior Threads MicroQuilter 100 Wt)
- Microtex Sharp or Non-Stick/Anti-Glue Needles, size 75/11 or 70/10 (Schmetz makes some nice needles to use, Black super fine & non-stick)
- Quilting gloves, Free-Motion quilting slider mat, extension table (if desired)
- Always, a good idea to bring your sewing machine manual

#### Additional Sewing machine items for finish work/binding the quilt:

- 80/12 standard sewing machine quilting needle
- 40-50 weight polyester or cotton thread. Color: Light Denim Blue
- Small sharp fine-tip or embroidery scissors (Recommended: Karen Kay Buckley brand red perfect curved scissors)
- Clips or pins
- Hand sewing needle and thread to tack binding



Add Mosaic designing to your Quilt making. Heidi will break down each step she takes to create a mosaic quilt including working from a photograph, how to draw shapes, recognizing values in the photos and translating them to the correct colors, and how to choose just the right fabrics for your quilt design. She'll share traditional and innovative design and cutting techniques and she'll show you how to do her NEWEST technique of putting the mosaic design together without the need for a light box or fabric marking tools. Two options for this class: Using a supplied kit you will be pre-cut, pre-fused applique pieces to build your own beautiful mini poinsettia quilt tile. Plus, Heidi will share her tips for successfully quilting and finishing your quilt tile.

Heidi Proffetty is a nationally recognized mosaic art quilter, quilting and sewing educator, and content contributor for Janome Sewing Machines. Known for her distinctive mosaic quilting style, Heidi combines her own original digital artwork with innovative quilt-making techniques. She shares both digital and traditional mosaic quilt making techniques with fellow quilters through classes, publications, and online platforms.

Her unique artistry and teaching expertise have been featured in AQ Magazine, Quilting Arts Magazine, Patchwork Professional, as well as on Quilting Arts TV and The Quilt Show.
