

Rapid Fire Lemoyne Star Introduction

Spend the day learning to make traditional Lemoyne Star blocks the Deb Tucker way. You'll be strip piecing, layer cutting, oversizing, and trimming down to create the easiest, quickest, most successful Lemoyne Star blocks ever.

We'll make several sizes throughout the day and have you well on your way to creating the free bonus project included with the instructions. But beware; you'll find it hard to stop once you know the secrets of this method.

Please note that the Rapid Fire® Lemoyne Star tool is required for this class. It should be purchased prior to arrival from a quilt shop near you, or directly from me at: **Studio180Design.net**

Please arrive with the listed strips precut and ready for use. There is no allotted time for this cutting during the class.

The sampler pictured was made with red and cream scraps. The total yards including the borders and binding break down as follows:

1¾ to 2 yards of assorted dark value fabrics (reds)

1½ to 1¾ yards of assorted light value fabrics (creams)

For class, we will be making several different size blocks: 6", 9", and 4". You may want to bring additional fabric to make additional blocks if time permits.

Precutting:

Please cut all strips the listed size by the half width of fabric

For one 6" block:

Cut two dark strips for star points 2" x hwof

Cut two light strips for background 3¼" x hwof

For one 9" block:

Cut two dark strips for star points 2½" x hwof

Cut two light strips for background 4" x hwof

For one 4" block:

Cut two dark strips for star points 1½" x hwof

Cut two light strips for background 2¾" x hwof



Equipment and Supplies

Required Tools:

- Rapid Fire® Lemoyne Star Tool
- Sewing Machine - in good working order (unless you are attending a machine sponsored class. Please check with your event coordinator for details)
- Neutral Colored Thread
- Rotary Cutter - new blade recommended
- Cutting Mat - 18" x 24" recommended
- General Purpose Ruler - 6" x 12" recommended
- Invisigrip™ - for back of tool
- General Sewing Tools - scissors, seam ripper, pins, etc.

Optional Equipment

- Additional Lighting
- Extension Cord
- Chair Cushion
- Camera
