### March 1, 2026

The meeting was called to order by Co-President Melissa Greevy at 2:00 PM Darlene Schardt from the York Guild was visiting with their raffle quilt and selling tickets.

Local quilt artist, Barb Wilke, shared with us her many colorful quilts. She is a retired Art teacher from York. Her work has been shown at some of the largest quilt shows in the country. She learned embroidery as a child, which led to turning those pieces into quilts.

She "bedazzles" some of her quilts to add sparkle and adds pieces of metal, which adds another texture. She was very entertaining and talented.

### New Business

All quilts needed for the Quilt Bingo have been donated. There are approximately 20 tickets left. Debbie needs door prizes if you committed to donating some.

The budget is still in the works, but it will be presented via email soon.

The quilt show equipment has been sold for \$500. A deposit of \$250 has been received. The equipment will be picked up as soon as the weather cooperates.
