Ruler Class: 101 and Beyond Blocks/Borders

Students will learn to use acrylic rulers for machine quilting on a domestic machine. Students will learn basic skills within block and border designs. As the basic skills are achieved, we will move on to more detailed work that can then be paired with free motion quilting. This will not be a hurry up and wait kind of class. As individuals progress at different speeds it is my job to keep each student working at their pace so everyone can benefit from the class.

Supply List: A **sewing machine** of your choice in good working order. The **ruler foot** for your machine. Bernina owners will use foot #72. All other machine owners please refer to the recommended foot by your manufacturer. You will need **two acrylic quilting rulers**. Please have **a straight edge ruler and one with an arc or circular** ruler with $\frac{1}{4}$ markings on them. There are many on the market. Please make sure you have **the $\frac{1}{4}$ inch** as there are also $\frac{1}{8}$ " on the market, I do not recommend the $\frac{1}{8}$ ". I will have a supply of different rulers that people can use after basic skills are achieved. Please do not try this technique without the proper foot and rulers as your safety may be compromised and damage to your machine may be a costly mistake. **Please** mark all of your tools with your name so everyone goes home with what they came with.

Other Supplies

- thread (cotton works best)
- a small pair of scissors or thread clippers
- (2-3) fabric /batting sandwiches approximately 18" x 24". These are scraps of muslin or cotton fabric with batting inside, plain in color.
- either a 6" square ruler or a straight edge quilting ruler as we will be mocking up quilt blocks and borders to quilt.
- pencil or a blue water- soluble marking pen.
