Bingo is also being hosted regularly at the office now, also open to all. Come for the company and the laughter! Your host, Kristine, does an outstanding job. The next game day is Wednesday, April 10th from 9:30 a.m.-10:45 a.m. On Saturday, May 11th, we'll be hosting a Makers' Market and Vendor Fair. That she is a local business owner herself means she also understands the needs of our partner employers. At the same time, we extend hearty thanks to Stephanie Lindgren who has been wearing an extra hat and who has ensured Social Security reporting and other key Supported Employment tasks have been kept up.

We have reconstituted our training committee and are updating our training plan now. We would very much like to add additional participants and shared living providers to the committee so if you are interested, please let me know. The commitment is for just a few meetings a year, but your input is vital. The committee has already identified some new focus areas for the next training plan including training for managers, LGBTQ+ awareness and sensitivity, and improved onboarding and training for new employees.

In closing, as are the area schools, we will be treating April 8 (Eclipse Day) as an inclement weather day, as we have been advised to expect significant road congestion. Most community support will be canceled, though residential and employment supports will be provided. The office will be open but we are encouraging office staff to work remotely if possible.


