NEW: Just A Green Worship Minute: Bin Wondering About Pickup?

The city of Brandon is adjusting the collecting of garbage, recycling and composting bins starting the week of June 17th. This is an important change and one that we should all be good with, as it will save us both carbon emissions and money. The reduced number of trips that trucks take to pick up (2 trips a week to your house instead of 3) will save wear and tear on the trucks as well as save carbon and the use of fossil fuels to keep those trucks going. This is an efficient use of our tax dollars.

It's important to remember that you should only put out your bin, if it is full. It takes the same amount of time and carbon to empty a full bin as it does a half-full bin.

Many have expressed concern that they have more recycling than fit in their bins in 2 weeks. Remember to crush cans and milk cartons, break down cardboard boxes, flatten as much as you can to allow more in your bin. If you have a lot of cardboard one week, remember there are recycling bins in other parts of the city you can make use of. If you have a medium cart, you can request a larger cart from the city.

This new schedule may seem inconvenient, but the data shows that most households can manage a bi-weekly recycling and composting pickup. This schedule supports the sustainability goals of our city.

Included is the link to the calendar of pickups. Everything else is the same. Garbage goes out every week, recycling and compost every other. Be sure your bins are full before you put them out and remember there are larger bins that you can use for both recycling and compost throughout the city.


