Reservations (although not necessary) will be accepted. If a delivery is your preference, please call the church office with pertinent info. and they will be delivered between 11:30-12 Noon.

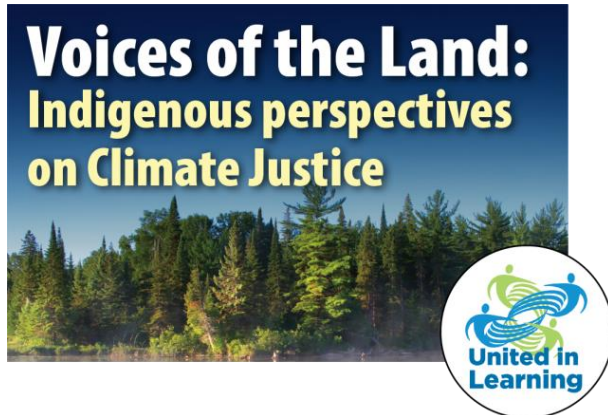

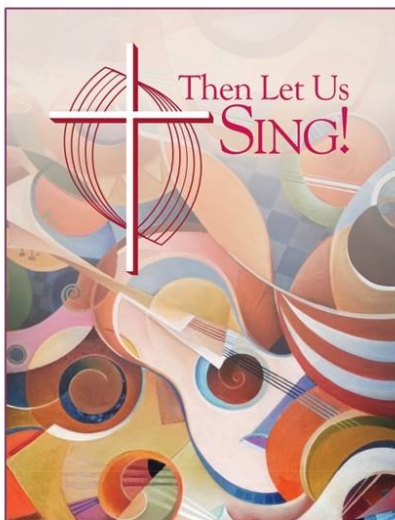
