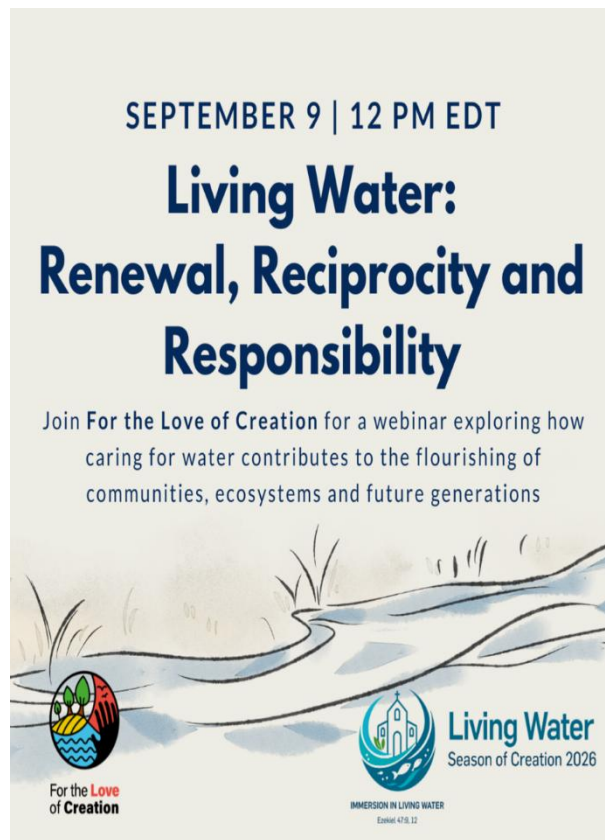
9 September - Living Water: Renewal, Reciprocity and Responsibility Webinar

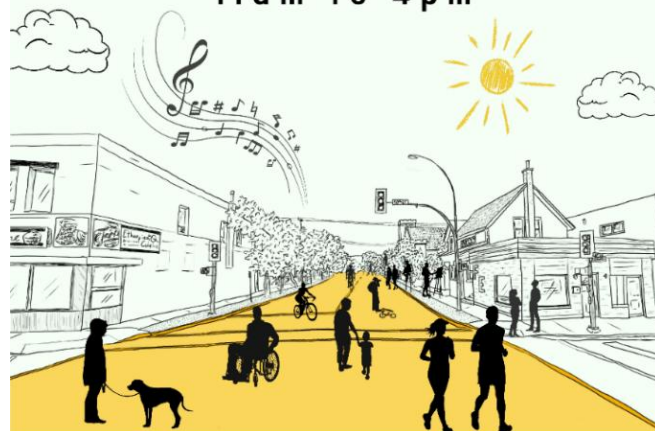
