March 11, 2008

The meeting was called to order by Jerome Haggemiller at 8:12 PM. Also present were Andy Anderson, Connie Marshal, Mary Bettermann and 12 other guest. Don Henning was not present

The Pledge of Allegiance was said.

Ralph Beulke made motion to nominate Pat Riedel for moderator and Charles Bettermann seconded. Motion Carried. All in favor

Charles Bettermann made motion to except last years minutes and Ralph Beulke seconded. Motion carried. All in favor

Jerome Haggemiller reported on the roads: We do a road tour right before road restrictions go off. In 2007 we did some matting on Willow Road. In 2008 possible matting will be done on Miltona Carlos Rd. Willow Rd. and West Miltona Rd. the price previously was around \$13 per foot and matting will be around \$44,000 for these projects. We will be taking over Miltona Woods, Smokey Timbers Development, Golf Course once the roads are paved. Motion by Rick Mittag seconded by Brad Vogt. All in favor.

Andy Anderson reported on the Fire Board: Andy stated the fire department went on 54 calls. That's medical & Fire. That's a lot of calls for such a small town. Budget is down from last year. We are bugeted \$56,195.00. The township pays 79% of the budget. Charles Bettermann made motion and Rick Mittag seconded. Motion carried. All in favor

Jerome Haggemiller reported on the Weeds: All right aways were sprayed. Richard mowes the road ditches two times. We do weed inspections and the supervisors will check again and then turned it over to the county. Motion made by Ralph Beulke seconded by Brad Vogt. All in favor

Jerome Haggemiller reported on the Gophers: we paid out \$92.75 last year. \$2.00 for pocket gophers and \$.25 for striped. Motion by Brad Vogt seconded by Ralph Beulke. All in favor.

Assessors Report by Gary Anderson: Andy reported that Matt Ticken said they have 244 Ag Parcel, 2 timber, 541 seasonal, 466 Full time, 28 Commerical and 82 other. Motion by Charles Bettermann seconded by Rick Mittag. All in favor.

NEW BUSINESS

Jerome Haggemiller reported on the sewer: Jerome stated: Plans & Specs were submitted a year ago and they should know something by March 26 as this is the last day for public comment on the permit and EAW. We are still eligible to get a low interest loan. . Public Hearing is set for May 17th to update everyone. Motion by Ralph Beulke seconded by Charles Bettermann. All in favor.
