

Miltona Township Minutes of the Regular Monthly Meeting

September 13, 2010

The meeting was called to order by Jerome Haggemiller at 5:30 pm. Present were Jerome Haggemiller, Keith Baldwin, Connie Marshall, Tom Blank, and 11 guests. All present stood and recited the Pledge of Allegiance.

The minutes of the last regular meeting, were read by Tom Blank. A motion by Keith to approve the minutes as read and corrected, seconded by Jerome, motion carried.

TREASURERS REPORT

Connie gave the treasurers report which showed a balance in money market account of \$ 247,054.59 and checking \$505.00 for a total of \$ 247,559.59. Motion by Keith to approve the treasurer's report, seconded by Jerome, motion passed.

Motion by Keith to approve the bills as presented on back of agenda seconded by Jerome, motion passed.

OLD BUSINESS

Ted Steidl from Carlos Township was present and handed out the findings from their grant work, discussion Followed about the results and Tom talked about the turnout for the meeting here in August. No one from the survey area was in attendance but 7 did return their survey via mail. The interest portion for the bond will be \$42,989, bringing the tax levy for 2010/2011 to \$273,782; a decrease of \$10,073 from last year's levy.

New Business

Resident on Willow Road would like to see another 300' have chloride applied in 2011. Discussion about the cost of chloride and available options. We currently contract through the County for it at a price of \$ 0.985 a gallon. Magnesium Chloride might be a less expensive option through a different contractor. Gary Tadora presented a petition to begin the process to blacktop Vermont Access Road, ~2 miles. Tom will verify the accuracy of the petitioners and proceed. The Hams Creek ditch on East Lake Miltona Drive needs some safety measures in place. Andy has acquired the permit from the DNR and we will go ahead and proceed with this and hopefully next year be able to improve the safety of the road around the creek. Steve Fromming spoke on behalf of Marvin Hartwig in hopes of having the township take over the road at the end of Smokey Timbers Road. A resident in the audience pointed out that the township has an ordinance that it will not take over a road until it is paved with asphalt. This is up to county specs but Jerome will contact Dave Robley and verify the condition of the road. We need to set a sign tour time to inspect the conditions of the reflection of road signs. Wed out for Jerome, Thursday bad for Tom. Keith is open any time, we will schedule one at our next meeting when Andy is available. Carlos Township has a new road maintenance contractor and would like to

Tom will draft an agreement between the two Townships and have it signed by Carlos at their next meeting and available for signing at our next meeting.


Floor Business

Next Meeting will be set for Monday October 4th, at 5:30 pm at the Miltona Fire Hall.


As there were no further items on the agenda to discuss, a motion to adjourn by Jerome, seconded by Keith, motion passed 6:50 pm.
