An option is for townships to arrange for their checks to be signed by only one officer if: (1) the township board has audited and approved the claim; (2) the clerk has indicated his or her approval that the board took the action indicated; (3) the treasurer indicates there is money available in the township's account to pay the claims; (4) the board has delegated the authority to issue the check; and (5) each of these elements are document in the township board minutes. The board discussed each point to make sure we adhere to the necessary action needed to have only two of the three signatures sign checks tonight.

Old Business-Stop sign has been installed at he T-intersection of S Lake Miltona Dr and E Lake Miltona Dr. Road tour notes from Wade were in the hands of Supervisors and with no additions or deductions, Tom will pass them back to R&R to begin the spring work. Property Taxes will be due on the usual date, no changed by Auditors.

New Business- Discussed mail voting and decided not to conduct the upcomine elections this way so there is no need for Resolution 2020-1. A motion by Matt and seconded by Steve to approve Resolution 2020-2 Jim and Judys 3.2 License, motion carried 3-0. Jim Penkivech emailed a list of concerns on E Lake Miltona Road for us to look at when time comes for repairs on road. LRES will begin work on natural gas on May 18 going down E Lake Miltona Road.
