
A motion by Steve and seconded by Matt to accept the bills, motion carried 3-0.

Old Business- Discussed the erosion control measures that are still in place on E Lake Milona and possible removal of such in the near future. Catch basin just south of the T-intersection needs to be raised yet. Chloride has been going down as calls for it have been coming in wondering when.

New Business- Private power lines were put in under the road on Smokey Timbers Road at the 15227 address; homeowner was notified to bore not trench and any future road development by township that resulted in damage to these lines would be the homeowners responsibility and not township. A copy of these minutes will be given to the current homeowner to keep with his records in case the property is ever sold. Tom will forward a copy of the signed minutes on. Don Shircliff was not in attendance to discuss the north end of Parview Lane and the township taking it over. This is part of PARVIEW ESTATES TOWNHOMES and not a dedicated road. Tom will bring back printout of the property and look at again next month. John Tursi inquired about the speed limit on E Lake Milona and reducing it to 20 mph. Supervisor's position is that 30 mph is as slow as we can post it. The 30 mph signs had been put in the last couple of years.
