**TREASURERS REPORT-** Treasurers report showed a book balance of \$ 1,250.20, and Money Market Account with \$ 255,658.47 for total funds of \$256,908.67. Motion by Jarrod and seconded by Jerome to accept Treasurers report, motion carried 2-0.

A motion by Jerome and seconded by Jarrod to accept the bills, motion carried 2-0.

**Old Business-** Pemberton Law office has still not returned an opinion on SSD ordinance besides numerous calls there. Township will not pass ordinance anyway until the final amount is known to be assessed. Tom and Jerome met with Widseth, design is done on the Vermont Access Road but no cost estimate as of yet. Stressed the importance of getting those numbers for our August meeting so we can have a public hearing before everyone leaves the cabins. Township plans on rebuilding the road this fall and asphalt next year if all goes as planned and approved. Policy is for Township to pay for maintenance of road, this is two different projects, rebuilding and paving of Vermont Access Road. There is additional grant money available for projects such as this thru other avenues as well and people are working on this for the township. Only thing left is final grass grow in and should have final bill for August meeting and schedule a public hearing for final assessment in August. Tom contacted MN DOT about the process for a potential culvert under Willow Road, it is in State R/W and need a permit from them to do this. Irene paving on John Sarkilahti driveway has been looked at by contractor and said he would be back to clean it up. Tom, Jerome, Matt, Steph, Jarrod and backups Randy and Maureen Winger will be election judges this fall. Training is necessary and will be online through county.

**New Business-** Discussion about speed limit signs and more chloride on Oak Tree Road, township will not be putting any more chloride down and speed limit signs need research for changing. Tom will call him back. Request to look into resurfacing Hidden Valley Road from 14 back to the "Y". Tom will contact Pam at Leaf Valley about this possibility after the Shircliff project is complete. Trees down on Steve Herth on unmaintained portion of R/W. Township will not be cleaning it up as it is in the middle of a stand of trees. Policy is to clean up trees in R/W but not on private property.


