Shouldering needs to be done on E Lake Miltona Drive by Viking Bay and something needs to be done with the Trisko approach to reduce the mud and material coming on to E Lake Miltona Dr. Jerome will contact Bargen and ask for a quote on the crack filling of asphalt roads in township. 14 and W Miltona needs grass cut down at the intersection.
