A motion by Matt and seconded by Jarrod to accept the bills. Motion carried 3-0.






Thomas Blank called the meeting to order at 5:15 pm. Present were Jarrod Oberg, Matt Kugler, and Stephanie Stueve.


Purpose of meeting was to canvass the election results and certify the results of the township elections. 742 persons were registered to vote prior to poll opening. 21 people registered to vote on election day. 491 signatures were recorder on the roster and another 79 persons voted absentee for a total of 570 votes cast.

Matt Kuger won the Supervisor "B" position with 457 votes. Jerome Haggemiller won the Supervisor "C" position with 463 votes.


With no other business to attend to a motion by Jarrod and seconded by Matt to adjourn meeting 5:22 pm. Motion carried 4-0.
