Motion by Jarrod and seconded by Matt to accept Treasurers report, motion carried 3-0.

A motion by Jarrod and seconded by Matt to accept the bills totaling \$ 111,139.96, motion carried 3-0.



New Business Tree trimming needs to be done on N Lake Milona Dr near the culvert, box elder tree and 45 others need to be removed. N Lake Milona Dr roadside erosion needs to be repaired due to the muskrats. Leaf Valley is looking at an overlay on Hidden Valley road next year which we will participate with since half the road is in Milona Township.

Floor- CD is maturing and can be renewed for 6 months at 5.16%. Tami Bredeson is no longer pursuing USDA grant money since the township doesn't qualify anymore on income levels. Mike Kopitzke asked Jerome to read a letter he had written about his concerns on Vermont Access Road.
