Tom and Jerome attended the DRT meeting on the development off 29 and Bayview Dr.

New Business-Bargen Road work quote needs to be broken down by project, Jerome will contact them. Chloride quote for 2026 was presented and compared to last year and a motion by Matt and seconded by Brent to accept the quote, motion carried 3-0. County dispatch is interested in having another siren installed in the township and inquired about township position on costs and continued maintenance for another one. Tom will talk to dispatch about the idea.

Floor- Individuals on south end of E Vermont don't want chloride applied. Jerome instructed them to talk to all the residents of the road and bring back signatures of all those who do not want chloride applied.
