

Milona Township Minutes of the Regular Monthly Meeting

Jerome Haggemiller called the meeting to order at 7:00 pm. Present were Brent Boesl, Steph Stueve, Tom Blank, and 4 guests. All present stood and recited the Pledge of Allegiance. A motion by Brent and seconded by Jerome to accept the December minutes, Motion carried 2-0.

**TREASURERS REPORT-** Treasurers report showed a balance in Checking of \$5,745.54, Money Market Account with \$1,002.54, Intrafi Account with \$461,369.01, for total funds of \$468,117.09. Motion by Jerome and seconded by Brent to accept Treasurers report, motion carried 2-0.

A motion by Jerome and seconded by Brent to accept the bills totaling \$100,347.88, motion carried 2-0. Steph will hold the Glenwood State Bank bond payment until the end of the month. Steph will only transfer enough into checking to cover the bills, and she will transfer an additional amount near the end of the month to cover the bond payment. Tom will drop off the final bond payment in the morning at Old National Bank, there may be a difference on the one-day interest due, roughly \$3.85 depending on how the bank charges the final day. Tom will pay for that in cash if there is a difference and be reimbursed for his expenses.

A motion by Brent and seconded by Jerome for the following board setup as discussed, Jerome to remain as Chairperson, Matt as the Vice-Chair, committee assignments as follows, everyone to be on Road and Weed Committees and Brent to be on Fire Committee, motion carried 2-0. A motion by Jerome and seconded by Brent for the Echo Press and The Independent, website, and door of Community Center the official instruments for notice, motion carried 2-0. A motion by Jerome and seconded by Brent for First Western Bank & Trust the official Depository, motion carried 2-0. A motion by Brent and seconded by Jerome authorizing Thomas Blank to conduct township business in the name of the Board and authorizing Stephanie Stueve to transfer funds from the saving into check and checking into savings as business warrants, motion carried 2-0. A motion by Brent and seconded by Jerome for mileage at .725, Meetings \$125.00 for Chairperson, \$100 for Supervisors, Clerk and Treasurer, the Supervisors/Treasurer wages will be \$20/HR with a \$900 salary for the Treasurer to be paid half in June and half in December, Clerk \$22/HR, Election Judges \$20/HR, Head Election Judge \$25/HR and the moderator of annual meeting \$25. motion carried 2-0.

**Old Business** Stop signs will remain in place on Vermont Access Road for now. Supervisors would like to see county wide rifle zone when rezoning goes into effect this year.

**New Business-** Tom and Brent will attend the fire board meeting on Wednesday 4 February at the Community Center. Ben Dukowitz was in attendance requesting a site visit and letter from township allowing him to trim tree branches in the right-of-way along West Sandy Beach DR NW and Sandy Beach DR Ne.



At 7:49 pm, a motion was made by Jerome and seconded by Brent to recess this meeting and reconvened at 8 am tomorrow morning at West Sandy Beach Dr NW, motion carried 2-0.

Meeting was reconvened at 9:01 Tuesday, 13 January to review the tree branches along the right-of-way to be removed, primarily a boxelder branch on the corner as well as a couple other branches hanging over the road. A motion by Jerome to allow Ben or his agent to trim tree branches within the right-of-way of West Sandy Beach DR NW and Sandy Beach DR NE and to contact landowners for permission to do such if outside the limits of the township right-of-way, seconded by Brent, motion carried 2-0. Tom will draft a letter for Ben with this language for his use and records.

A motion by Brent, second by Jerome to adjourn, motion carried 9:01 am.

Next Meeting will be set for Monday 9 February, 2026 at 7:00 pm at the Miltoona Community Center with Board of Audit to follow.
