# City of Thompson Falls Engineer Report City Council Meeting July 8, 2024

## City of Thompson Falls Project Updates:

## Wastewater System Improvements Ph. 1 & 2:

- City and Great West have requested RAZZ to sign substantial completion certification (dated back to when the wastewater treatment plant was put into official use as designed)
  - We have not received certification signed back yet.
  - o In general, construction is complete, the sewer collection system and wastewater treatment site are operating within permit limits. There are some warranty items still being addressed.
  - We can not formally issue substantial completion until we have this certificate and we are waiting on RAZZ. GWE has requested this form again at the end of June but have not received it yet.
- Great West is currently drafting the Operation and Maintenance Manual, incorporating asbuilts received from RAZZ & creating an individual service/grinder pump reference manual.
- Great West is also still completing on-going grant administration and coordinating grant close-out items.
- Great West will have bid documents ready within the next week or two to begin bidding out sludge work (advertising for a couple of weeks before opening bids). This is work that was change ordered out of RAZZ's general contract. This work will be covered in the existing project budget (RD Grant funds).

## Wastewater System Improvements Ph 3 & 4:

- Great West plans to submit to DEQ in the next couple of weeks, some of this has been
  delayed a couple of months as we have finalized sewer main locations/design. The Mayor
  and Neil have worked with local landowners to get verbal agreement on easement
  locations, which allows GWE to finalize design and submit to DEQ.
  - While the project is being reviewed at DEQ, the geotechnical report will be finalized and incorporated into the project documents for bidding, electrical engineering will be completed.
  - Other permits (BNSF, MDT as needed) will be submitted concurrently with DEQ review.
- Once DEQ approval and easements are finalized, we will receive funding agency approval to go out for bidding.
- Construction calendar days will be approximately 500 days; therefore the Contractor will
  have two construction seasons to complete the work, I would assume the contractor will
  start later this year (baring contractor and bid dates) and work up until winter shutdown.

## Water System Improvements

- Field studies are being completed for well source analysis currently. We will be reviewing the findings with the City within the next month
- Water System replacement design has been started.
- Great West has prioritized Church street as an emergency replacement.
  - o This has been designed
  - GWE has met with ARPA and discussed this preliminarily with RD to ensure funding agencies are good to go. The plan is to use ARPA funds readily available to complete this work.
  - o Construction cost is estimated at \$400,000-\$500,000 and this will be used out of existing water project funds.
  - We are confirming if the City can expedite the bidding process, ARPA is checking what the requirements are, we will likely need the City's legal council to weigh in as well.

## Stormwater PER

- The city was awarded planning funds to complete a stormwater PER, recently the City was awarded the MCEP planning grant (previously received RRG) and GWE will work on startup conditions with the City.
  - Once startup conditions are met, GWE will start on the Stormwater PER and develop a schedule with the City for meetings/work sessions and completing the PER.

## **Growth Policy Update**

 The City needs to update the existing Growth Policy. The City has requested Great West assist them on the Growth Policy. A planning grant will open in Nov. from CDBG that Great West recommends the City go after to help fund the Growth Policy update. In the meantime, there are tasks and discussions the City can begin to have.

## Request for item to be placed on Agenda - Thompson Falls City Council

I am writing to respectfully request a change of Section 8.06.18 of the city ordinance, to allow operation and maintenance of dog kennels within the city limits. The current ordinance is:

"Section 8.06.18 Private Dog Kennels. It shall be unlawful for any person to maintain or operate or cause to be maintained or operated, any place within the city any dog kennel."

I believe regulated dog kennels can benefit our community, offering:

- 1. Support for Pet Owners: Providing a safe, clean, and reliable place for dog boarding.
- 2. Economic Benefits: Creating job opportunities within the city.
- 3. Animal Welfare: Offering well-maintained and supervised environments for dogs.
- 4. Community Engagement: Foster a more pet-friendly community with pet events.

In support of this request, a very short (5-day) survey of local residents was conducted. Over 100 citizens emphasized a need for such a facility when they traveled or had unexpected care needs.

Additionally, our city faces issues with loose dogs, posing safety risks and requiring police resources. A regulated dog kennel could mitigate this by securing stray dogs, promoting responsible pet ownership and contributing to a safer community.

To address concerns about public health and safety, I propose that the city implement regulations for dog kennels, which could include:

- Licensing requirements.
- Mandatory health and safety standards to ensure clean and humane conditions.
- Regular inspections by city officials to ensure compliance with all regulations.
- Noise control measures to minimize disturbances to neighboring properties.

By changing Section 8.06.18 to allow for regulated dog kennels, we can balance the needs and interests of pet owners and the broader community. I would be happy to discuss this proposal further and provide any additional information needed.
