## NOTES AND CLARIFICATIONS:

Vision Gymnastics has been open since June 1, 2020 and we have not had any COVID breakouts within our facility. We have been very fortunate! We attribute our success to 3 important factors (other than disinfecting which our facility regular does anyway):

- 1. Temperature checks and washing hands by EVERY PERSON that walks into the building
- 2. Carpool drop off and pick up because it limits the number of people coming in and out of the building
- 3. Limited spectators on any given night which limits congestion in the lobby as well as our viewing area

## Being forced to do things differently has helped us learn some things that we would have otherwise not realized! What have we learned?

- Less spectators means less distractions so students have been much more focused during class attributing to the most move ups that we have had in such a short time in our history! Our students' success is important to us so we want to continue limiting visitors to an occasional visit – we do not have room for every student to have every family member come in each week. Please be courteous to others and limit your visits!
- 2) Carpool drop off and pick is here to stay because not only does it limit the number of people entering and exiting the facility but we are loving the opportunity to connect with parents face to face during drop off. Carpool also helps with our limited number of parking spaces and really helps with the safety of our students!!
